

Mark your calendar now for the Middle PA District Heritage Fair at Camp Blue Diamond this fall! Our annual festival of Food, Fun, Friends and Family will be on Sept. 21<sup>st</sup>. There will be tons of food, loads of children's activities, an auction, the Dunk the Dunker Tank, crafts, demonstrations and more! It's a family reunion for all your camp and church friends as we eat, visit with friends, and have fun.



Has your church decided how to participate for 2024? Start making plans. A Camp or District rep will be calling soon to find out what you are planning. Food and craft booths are always welcome, or perhaps your church would like to run a game, help in the Children's area or do a demonstration. Heritage Fair starts with breakfast at 6:30 in the Lodge. Booths open at 8:30. The Auction is from 11 - 1 p.m. Booths, activities and the fair typically end around 2 p.m. It's going to be great!

If your church does not regularly participate there are still ways you can help at Heritage Fair. We have a wide variety of roles that you can volunteer for. Volunteer shifts can last as little as 15 minutes. Please consider helping out in a new way. Contact Camp today if you can help!

A winter renovation to the industrial kitchen in the main lodge has been completed. This new equipment was quickly put to the test and has already helped the staff produce over 5,200 meals through the first few months of 2024.

The original ovens and griddle were replaced with a double stack convection oven, a range with a stovetop with 6 burners and a large griddle. This new equipment has drastically increased the efficiency of the kitchen.

Planning has started on the final project of the capital campaign, a multipurpose building in the area near the heart of camp. We are currently working through some



sewage requirements with the state. After that we anticipate developing final plans for what the building will look like and the exact location. This new building will be a great addition for summer camp & outdoor school as well as possibly enhancing Heritage Fair and other large group activities.

#### Male Counselors and Nurses Needed!

We are blessed to have filled most of our summer camp positions, but are still in need of **Male Counselors**. Applicants must be at least 18, committed Christians, enjoy kids, and be able to live in harmony with others. Pay ranges from \$250 - \$300/week. Room & board is provided. Camp runs from June 6<sup>th</sup> to July 27<sup>th</sup>. Application information can be found at *campbluediamond.org*.

**Volunteer Nurses** (RN's, MD's & PA's) are present for each week of summer camp. Nurses are responsible for giving meds and treating injured or sick campers. Nurses live in the Ouch House are welcome to bring their families. Nurses are still needed for June 23-28, June 30-July 3 and July 14-19.
