As we proceed through Advent and await the birth of the Messiah, we here at Camp Blue Diamond wanted to take time to reflect on our year and say thank you. Through the generosity of the supporters of Camp Blue Diamond, we were able to welcome 342 campers this past summer. This is an increase of over 5% from 2023. Of these 342 campers, 73 did not claim to be affiliated with a church. For some of these children and youth, the week they spend at Camp Blue Diamond may have been their only opportunity to hear about the life changing good news of Jesus Christ. They were able to witness Christians living with each other in harmony and working through any differences they may have had with the help of our theme: *Linked By Love*.

Through your generosity we were able to provide scholarships to nearly 40 campers that totaled nearly \$6,000. Without your support, many on these campers would not have had the opportunity to attend summer camp.

I am reminded of two sisters that came to Camp Blue Diamond for the first time this past summer. These girls do not have the opportunity to attend church, and their home life is unstable at best. When they first arrived, the girls were unfamiliar with the concepts that many of our campers take for granted. Throughout the week the girls became more comfortable and opened up to the counselors. They were amazed that there is this place where they are loved and cared for unconditionally, and they responded to the life changing news of a God that loves them. By the end of the week, they didn't want to leave and made sure they stayed around for that one last game of gaga ball. It was only through you as supporters that we had this opportunity to share all these things with the girls.

Because of your generous support we are also able to keep our prices as low as possible. Camp Blue Diamond is proud to be the least expensive Church of the Brethren summer camp that is also ACA accredited in the denomination. We have also worked hard over the last few years to increase the pay for our counselors. While we are not paying them anywhere near what they are worth for the ministry they provide, we know how important they are and are grateful for the progress we have made.

As we close out 2024 and look ahead to 2025, we want to ask you to continue to support Camp Blue Diamond. Certainly, the best thing everyone can do is pray for our campers and staff, that we would stay safe and share the love of Jesus. Summer Staff, CITs (Counselor In Training) & Vol. Nurses Are Needed

If you, or someone you know, loves camp and kids, working at camp would be a wonderful adventure for them! Counselors must be at least 18, committed Christians, enjoy kids, and be able to live in harmony with others. Being a part of the camp staff is a fantastic! Staff members grow in faith, leadership and communication skills, as well as live in community with other like-minded Christians. For those interested in teaching, ministry or social work (or being a parent), it's terrific on-the-job training! Maintenance & Kitchen staff need to be at least



16, and work 8-hour days, with time off in the evenings to join the activities. Pay is \$250 - \$300/week, based on position and experience. Room & board provided. Camp runs June 6 – July 27. Applications are available at *campbluediamond.org*. Don't wait too long to apply! We are hiring now!

Being a CIT is a great way to experience counseling. CIT's are 9th, 10th & 11th graders who help a counselor with a boys' or girls' unit. First time CIT's need to attend CIT Camp on June 2nd & 3rd. After completing CIT Camp, they can assist with a Junior, Pioneer or Tenderfoot camp.

Nurses (RN's, PA's and MD's) are needed for summer camp. Nurses are responsible for administering meds and treating injured or sick campers. Nurses are housed in the Ouch House and may bring their spouse and family. Annual Dinner: March 21 & 22

Camp Blue Diamond's Annual Dinner will be held March 21st & 22nd. We are excited to welcome our many friends that make this annual fundraising dinner a priority! This event raises funds each year to help offset the cost of summer camp, keeping it affordable for everyone, along with allocating funds towards a special project.

Dinner on Friday evening will begin at 6:30pm while Saturday evening's dinner will begin at 5:30pm. We encourage everyone to come out for appetizers and fellowship with other camp supporters a half hour before the meal each night.

New Registration Software

In 2025 Camp Blue Diamond will be implementing a completely new software system for camp management called CAMPWISE. This integrated registration and database management software will greatly improve camp's overall operation and streamline the registration process for campers and their parents.

Some parents may have already received an email about this new registration software. Once registration is set up the first time, registering for future events at Camp Blue Diamond will become easier as much of the required information being saved on secure servers. Credit card and e-check payments made through this system are PCI Level 1 compliant (a secure standard) and are not stored in the CAMPWISE database.

Although camp has not purchased every component available, future upgrades will allow us to manage almost every aspect of camp, from camper registration to donor management to guest services in one convenient package.

While this new software is customizable to our program, we needed to implement a few changes to our processes to ensure the smoothest transition possible (see the note on church stipends below). If you encounter any problems during this new process, please do not hesitate to reach out to the office for assistance. You can of course still send in a paper copy of the registration just like in the past.

If you regularly attend a church that pays part or all the Camp Blue Diamond Summer Camp fee you will need the code for your church. You can get this code from your church or call our office at (814)667-2355.






