

PERKS OF BEING AN ADJUSTER

Claims adjusting is a demanding but extremely rewarding profession. The pay is good, and assisting people in getting back on their feet after a loss is a rewarding line of work. This is an ideal job for people who thrive in stressful situations and are looking for a way to assist in the aftermath of natural disasters.

Insurance adjusters are in high demand in any economy because claims are consistent regardless of the economy. Independent claims adjusters can expect annual earnings of more than \$100,000, while staff adjusters who work directly for insurance carriers can expect salaries ranging from \$45,000 to \$80,000+.


WHAT KIND OF ADJUSTER WILL YOU BE?

- Staff Adjuster
- Independent Adjuster

Staff adjusters work as year-round employees, typically full-time, for an insurance company.

Independent insurance adjusters are contractors who work for one or more insurance adjusting firms. The IA firms usually have a multitude of insurance companies as clients and the independent adjuster may handle claims for any one of those insurers, often multiple at once.

ADJUSTER LICENSE?**

No matter where you live, we have the training to help you obtain your adjuster license.

To start, you'll need to know whether your home state licenses insurance adjusters. Some states require anyone handling claims to be licensed as an insurance adjuster and other states do not. We call states that require an adjuster license "licensing states." Some states have special All-Lines Adjuster Licenses that cover all kinds of claims while others have separate licenses for different types of insurance.

What do you do if you live in a non-licensing state?

If you live in a non-licensing state, you should obtain a "Designated Home State" or DHS License. A DHS license basically works just like having your home state license and is vital if you want to work any claims outside of your non-licensing state.

What do you do if your home state requires a license?

If you live in a licensing state, you would start by finding out your state's process. One of the main steps will be to complete your state's licensing exam. There are two different ways this can be done: with pre-licensing classes which are typically 40 hour courses and include the test OR exam prep courses which prepare you for an exam you would have to take at a testing facility.

Reciprocal States

Reciprocity just means a state recognizes another state's licensing requirements. If you passed the exam of a state with similar requirements, they would waive the need for you to take another test. Reciprocity, or reciprocal licensing privileges allows a licensed adjuster to obtain another state(s) license without having to pass that specific state's exam.
