Championship: Shoulder-to-Shoulder Competition

You are invited to participate in the 2019 Georgia Veterans of Foreign Wars Air Rifle Championship

Championship Objectives: The **VFW sponsors the** Veterans of Foreign Wars Air Rifle Championship to promote rifle practice and firearm safety and to foster junior and adult participation in rifle competitions. Participation by as many teams and clubs as possible is encouraged. Shooting sports programs and competition also foster communication and competition across generations and provide opportunities for diverse groups, such as military/veterans, and disabled competitors to share a common interest.

VFW Sponsorship: The Georgia Veterans of Foreign Wars (VFW), the Ole Mill Range CTC (OMRCTC), Georgia Competitive Shooters, Inc., and Spalding County 4-H Shooting Sports (SC4-HSS) provide direct support for competition. GCS, Inc supports the Veterans of Foreign Wars Junior Air Rifle Championship by providing event promotion and conducting statistical operations for the State Championship competition. The Junior State Championship and the Open, Military/Veteran, and Disabled Competition will be held at the Ole Mill Range Complex in Griffin, Georgia on June 7-9, 2019.

Competition Categories

Junior Open Competition - The 2019 Georgia Veterans of Foreign Wars Open Air Rifle Championship is open to all junior shooting organizations that have school-age juniors as members or enrollees (high school seniors or below). Participating organizations can be individuals, junior clubs, school teams, 4-H clubs, JROTC units (Army, Air Force, Marine Corps or Navy) or other organizations with eligible junior members.

Open Category – those that do not fit into another category.

Military / Veteran Category – active military or veteran.

Disabled Category – As categorized by NRA.

Entering and Competing

Entries: Entries may be made by submitting a registration form (attached) and remitting the appropriate fee to:

Out of state entries are welcome, but the Georgia Champion must be a Georgia Resident.

Entry Fee: Entry fees for the 2019 competition are \$10.00 per competitor. The low entry fee is intended to encourage entry in this competition. Participating clubs and teams are urged to encourage as many athletes as possible to participate. Please mail in a check (payable to Georgia Competitive Shooters) with registration form found at the end of this program.

Targets and Scoring

Targets: This event will be shot on MegaLink Electronic targets. Scores will also be uploaded to the Orion Results website on the Georgia Competitive shooters Homepage.

Course of Fire

State Championship: The Championship competition is a shoulder-to-shoulder match with one 3x20 course of fire followed by a 10-shot final. Team scores will be the totals of the 3x20 scores fired by the four team members. Final round scores do not count in team totals. The final will be added to competitors' individual scores to determine individual rankings.

- Match 1: 20 shots prone
- Match 2: 20 shots standing
- Match 3: 20 shots kneeling
- Match 4: total of matches 1, 2, 3
- Match 5: 10 shot final
- Match 6: total of matches 4 and 5

Rules

The *National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules* and this **Official Program** govern this competition.

How to Enter

Entries may be submitted to Georgia Competitive Shooters. Entry fees for the competition are \$10.00 per competitor, with no additional charge for team entries. Participating clubs and teams are urged to encourage as many junior shooters as possible to participate. Please mail in a check (payable to Georgia Competitive Shooters).
