



U. S. ARMY NATIONAL JUNIOR AIR RIFLE Sectional

STATE CHAMPIONSHIP AND NATIONAL QUALIFIER
for the 2020 US Army Junior Rifle Championship

Griffin, GA: Nov 22, 23, 24, 29, 30, Dec 1

SUMMARY. The US Army National Air Rifle Sectional features a competition format that gives all participants a true shoulder-to-shoulder competition experience that is simultaneously a state championship and a national qualification. Competitors will fire Regional Air Rifle Competitions throughout the nation. The scores will be instantly uploaded into a national results list that displays state and national rankings. The U. S. Army Marksmanship Unit is administering the championship and will provide the national awards. In addition to the air rifle competition, USAMU will host an optional 50M Three Position competition. Only athletes qualifying for the National Air Rifle Championship will be eligible to enter the small bore competition.

NATIONAL COMPETITION 23 – 25 January 2020: The 2020 USAJAR National Championship will be an invitational only. The top 30 precision and sporter individuals and the top 30 teams in both disciplines will be invited to Fort Benning GA for the national championships. The top scores will be selected based only on the score posted onto the Orion scoring system at the states sectionals. The National Championship will be shot on the Suis Ascor electronic scoring system at the US Army Marksmanship Unit's Pool Indoor range.

Competition Events: The 2020 USANARC offers competition in the following events:

sporter class three-position individual and team* - 3x20

precision class standing position individual and team* – 60 shots

*teams consist of 5 members who must be named in advance, with the top 4 scores counting for the team total

Courses of Fire:

sporter air rifle event will fire a 3x20 course of fire

(20 shots in each position: prone, standing, and kneeling)

precision air rifle event will fire 60 shots standing

(60 standing)

Open Junior Competition: this event is open to all junior shooting organizations and individual juniors who are 18 years of age and younger

Entry Fee: \$6.00 per individual / **\$2.00 if entering as add-on to Ole Mill Invitational** (OMI fees apply, this is in addition)
