

NATIONAL JUNIOR AIR RIFLE Championship Sectional Qualifier

for the 2021 National Junior Air Rifle Championship

Griffin, GA: Nov. 9, Dec 12, 13

SUMMARY. The National Air Rifle Sectional features a competition format that gives all participants a true shoulder-to-shoulder competition experience that is simultaneously a state championship and a national qualification. Competitors will fire Regional Air Rifle Competitions throughout the nation. The scores will be uploaded into a national results list that displays state and national rankings. The XCount in conjunction with Georgia Competitive Shooters, Inc. is administering the championship and will provide the awards.

NATIONAL COMPETITION 21-23 January 2021: The 2021 National Junior Air Rifle Championship will be an invitational only. The top 15 precision and sporter individuals and the **top 15** teams in both disciplines will be **invited** to Griffin, GA for the national championships. The top scores will be selected based only on the score posted onto the Orion scoring system at the states sectionals. The National Championship will be shot on the Megalink electronic scoring system at the Ole Mill Indoor range.

Competition Events: The NJARC offers competition in the following events:

sporter class three-position individual and team* - 3x20

precision class standing position individual and team* – 60 shots

*teams consist of 5 members who must be named in advance, with the top 4 scores counting for the team total

Courses of Fire:

sporter class event will fire a 3x20 course of fire
(20 shots in each position: prone, standing, and kneeling)

precision air rifle event will fire 60 shots standing
(60 standing)

Open Junior Competition: this event is open to all junior shooting organizations and individual juniors who are 18 years of age and younger

Entry Fee: \$25.00 per individual competitor
