ELIGIBILITY: **All competitors must be individual members of USA Shooting.**
Please join or renew online at <http://www.usashooting.org/>, or call USA Shooting at 719.866.4743 to join or renew, or mail your form and payment to USA Shooting. **Please join or renew well in advance (NOW!)** so that your updated **membership expiration date and membership number are available for you to provide on the advance entry form.** Go online now!

This competition is open to competitors born in 2001 or later.

RESIDENCE: Each competitor may claim residence in only one state and must declare the state of residence on the entry form. Residents are eligible for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place USA Shooting State Champion medallions. Residency is defined as to where the competitor holds a current and valid driver's license. If the competitor does not have a drivers license, residency is then defined as to where the competitor's parents/guardians reside. Non-residents may compete for invitations to the National Championship and are encouraged to do so. Non-residents are not eligible for state awards.

ENTRY: Only scores from a registered State Junior Olympic match will count for invitation to the National Junior Olympic Championships. Shooters *may not* compete in more than one Junior Olympic Shooting Championship (JOSC) qualifying event, regardless of location. Juniors who fire in their own home state JOSC will not be allowed to shoot in another state. Juniors from states which are not holding a state JOSC, and those who cannot attend their own state JOSC, will be allowed to enter as a non-resident in another state. Non-residents should declare their home state at entry and are not eligible for state resident awards.

CATEGORIES: The following categories will be used for the competition:
(Based on the age the competitor will be in the year 2020.)
- Junior (J1); age 18-20; competitors born from 2001-2003
- Intermediate Junior (J2); age 15-17; competitors born from 2004-2006
- Sub-Junior (J3); age 14 & under; competitors born in 2007 or later.

RULES: The current edition of the **ISSF** rules govern.

This includes the General Technical Rules and the Rifle and/or Pistol rules.

By entry into this competition, athletes and coaches acknowledge that they are bound by and responsible for knowing in advance and following all ISSF rules, the contents of this match program, and any Match Director's Bulletins.

This competition will be governed by 1) the ISSF rules, 2) USAS JO Rules Update (link below), 3) this match program, and 4) Match Director's Bulletins, which will be posted prominently at the range on the days of competition, if any are issued.

(USAS JO Rules update link: None for 2020-2021.)

(Rule exceptions. None for 2020-2021.)

HEALTH: Due to the pandemic, please adhere to the following protocols.

1. Everyone **MUST** wear a mask properly, covering nose and mouth at all times, except when an athlete is on their firing line and shooting.
2. Even though wearing masks, maintain social distancing.
3. Do not enter the building if you are sick.
4. Do not enter the building if you have been exposed to an infected person. A significant amount of viral spread takes place before symptoms appear. Feeling fine is not good enough.
5. Do not enter the building if you cannot or will not wear a mask fully covering your nose and mouth at all times.
6. Further protocols per the State of Georgia may apply.
7. Please contact the Match Director well in advance if you have questions or concerns.

AIR RIFLE: Standing position, 10 meters, indoors, electronic targets integer score
Combined preparation and sighting shots, 15 minutes
Women & Men, 60 record shots, 75 minutes (1 hour and 15 minutes)

.22 RIFLE: 3x20, kneeling, prone, standing, 50 feet, indoors, electronic targets
Combined preparation and kneeling sighting shots, 15 minutes
Women & Men, 3x20 record shots, 105 minutes (1 hour and 45 minutes)
Note that the changeover and sighting shots for prone and standing are included in the 105 minutes match time.

.22 PISTOL: Standing position, 50 feet, indoors, paper targets
All 5 shot sighting and record series on range command per rules
See rule 8.7.6.4 “Specific Rules for 25m Pistol” for event sequence
Women & Men, 30 precision record shots, 30 rapid fire record shots

Relay 1 – Sun 27 Dec 2020 – 9:00 am

EVENT TIMING: For **Air Rifle, Smallbore Rifle, Air Pistol**
30 minutes before published “Start” time:
- Athletes called to the line, set up equipment.
20 minutes before published “Start” time:
- Athlete briefing. **Athletes must be present on the firing line.**
15 minutes before published “Start” time:
- Preparation and unlimited sighting shots begins.
At published start time:
- Record shots firing begins.
For **Sport Pistol**, report to the firing line prior to the published start time.

- COACHING: Verbal (audible) coaching on the firing line will **not** be permitted during preparation and sighting time and record firing time. If a coach or parent wishes to call an athlete off the line, they must ask a range officer to relay the request to the athlete. Non-verbal (inaudible) coaching is allowed as long as it is not distracting to other athletes.
- SCORING
PROTESTS: All score protests will be handled according to the rules governing this competition.
- Rule GTR 6.16.5.2 – Electronic Targets
- Rule GTR 6.16.5.1 – Paper Targets (sport pistol event only)
- Only the competitor may challenge and only on their own target(s).
- Sport pistol challenges will be allowed immediately after scoring of all targets is completed. We use a public, open, three-coach-at-once scoring procedure to count, score, plug, decide plugs, and decide scoring protests, with athletes observing for learning purposes. After all scores are final, courtesy checks for learning purposes will be made available.
- TIES: All ties will be broken in accordance with the rules.
- PARTICIPATION
PINS: A Junior Olympic participation pin provided by USA Shooting will be given to each competitor.
- AWARDS: **Provided by USA Shooting** – USA Shooting will provide a gold medallion for the top resident individual, silver medallion for the 2nd place resident individual and a bronze medallion for the 3rd place resident individual in each event. These awards are statewide, not for each qualifier match when multiple are held in the state. Unused awards will be returned to USAS. Awards are given based on match score only (no finals in this competition).
- MAKE ENTRY: Entries must be made using the entry form enclosed with this program. Per USA Shooting, a **separate paper entry form must be fully completed for each athlete for each event.**
- Be sure to provide one valid email address that is actively used and checked.** Entries to this competition will be acknowledged and confirmed via email only, as will any changes or updates and your relay assignments. All national JOSCS invitations are sent directly to the athletes from USA Shooting via email only. **If your email address is incorrect, unreadable, or not monitored, you will miss important information, including your national invitation, which will be passed on to another athlete.**

Email and hand delivered entries are not accepted. All entries must be mailed. Paper forms, one for each event, and check or money order are required. **No tape or staples. Paper clips are okay.**

Sorry for all the rules – the physical and electronic paperwork, scoring and score reporting, and financials for this competition are quite extensive and time consuming. We need a consistent process to assure completeness and accuracy so no athlete is excluded due to missing paperwork.

ENTRY FEES: Advance entries: **\$25.00** per event – by deadlines below
Regular Entries: **\$35.00** per event – after deadlines below
Walk up entries: **\$50.00** per event – day of event entries

Make checks or money orders payable to Georgia Competitive Shooters.

Enter early; prime relays are expected to fill quickly and will be filled based on postmark date of confirmed entry. Entries are not confirmed, and relay assignments are not held for you, until after receipt of a legibly and fully completed paper entry form for each event accompanied by full payment.

ENTRIES CLOSE: Advance entries must be sent and postmarked on or before:
Mon 14 Dec 2020 – For December events
Mon 15 Feb 2021 – For February & March events

Mail early due to the holidays! Entries will be accepted to range capacity. **Prime relay times fill up very quickly.** The earlier you enter the better. Every effort will be made to accept all competitors who enter before the closing dates. **The full entry fee per event must be paid at time of entry.** In fairness to all, please honor the advance, regular, and walk up entry fees. This includes incomplete or unpaid entries which have not been completely resolved by the respective closing dates.

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellations must be postmarked and sent by mail or email on or before the respective closing dates above. Full refund less a \$5.00 processing cost.

RELAYS: On the entry forms, please be sure to request your 1st, 2nd, and 3rd choices of relay number for the event. Enter early as prime relays fill up fast!

If you have special requests (e.g. 2 athletes sharing equipment, 2 events athlete relay coordination, or entire team on 1 relay) please be sure to include a note with your entry. We will be happy to accommodate your

request if possible. The earlier we know, the higher the likelihood we may be able to accommodate.

Relay reservations are done with this priority:

1. December events – a combination of postmark and:
 - a. Georgia resident collegiate 2 event athletes
 - b. Georgia resident collegiate 1 event athletes
 - c. Non-resident collegiate 2 event athletes
 - d. Non-resident collegiate 1 event athletes
 - e. All other athletes (space available)
2. Feb/Mar events – a combination of postmark and:
 - a. All 2 event athletes
 - b. All 1 event athletes

You will be given a preliminary relay assignment for each event with the confirmation email sent to you after your entry is received and processed.

Please note, relay assignments may have to change based on the above priorities, range or schedule issues, or any other reason. You will receive another email if relay assignments have to change.

Squad lists with firing point assignments will be posted at the competition.

NATIONAL
INVITATIONS:

USA Shooting will issue invitations to the National Junior Olympics Shooting Championship events based on scores fired in state qualifier events. **There are three ways to earn an invitation:**

- **1) State Champion** – The athlete with the highest score in an event in each state is automatically invited if there are 6 or more entries state-wide and as long as their score meets or exceeds the minimum standards.

Men’s & Women’s Air Rifle.....500
Men’s & Women’s Smallbore.....500
Men’s & Women’s Air Pistol.....490
Men’s & Women’s Sport Pistol...500

- **2) Automatic** – All athletes who meet or exceed these score standards are automatically invited. These score standards are purposely set very high to ensure that capacity at the national match is not exceeded. (Some were lowered this year and are lower than previous at large.)

- **3) At Large** – Once all the State Champion and Automatic qualifiers are identified, then additional At-Large invitations are extended starting with the highest scores nationwide within each of the three age groups and working down until capacity is filled for each event. There are often **two waves** of At-Large invitations issued, though this can vary from year to year.

The actual minimum cut off scores vary each year, sometimes widely, based on how everyone shoots.

Last two years' (2019 & 2020) cutoff scores were not published in a form where they could be easily reported. The previous year's (2018) **first wave** At-Large cutoff scores are shown here, though are **subject to change** each year as scores come in. Note women have 40 and 60 shot scores. The 40 shot scores are actual from 2018 and the 60 shot scores are estimated. At-Large invitations, and the related cut off scores, are at the sole discretion of USA Shooting based on range capacity, dormitory space, and other match logistics.

The Ole Mill Range Complex is located at 129 N. Searcy Ave. at the corner of E. Broadway St. (Highway 155) in Griffin, GA 30233.

From Atlanta and I-75/I-85 North Metro Areas: Take I-75 South to exit 216 and go south on Highway 155 for approximately 8 miles until you reach the 4-way stop. Turn right (West) onto Jackson Rd. / Highway 155 for approximately 5 miles. The Ole Mill Range Complex will be on your left, one mile inside the city limits of Griffin.

UNLOADING

Unloading may be performed in the fenced area in front of the range on North Searcy Ave. **Vehicles must then be immediately moved.** This is a courtesy to others and a safety issue.

PARKING

Park in one of the three (3) adjacent lots outside the fenced in area.
