2025 FEBRUARY MONTHLY MATCH

OVERVIEW:

The OMRC Monthly Matches will take place at the Ole Mill Range Complex CTC. The competitions are provided to increase competitive opportunities for athletes in air rifle, air pistol, and smallbore. The OMRC range offers 36 10-meter firing points and 14 50-foot smallbore firing points. Events feature an Air Rifle 3x20 (3PAR), 60 Shot Air Rifle Standing (SAR), 60 Shot Air Pistol (AP), and Smallbore 3x20 (3PSB).

DATE: February 9, February 22 (more relays will be added if needed, must be 5 or more on each relay.)

EVENTS:

3PAR 3x20 – Competitors of all ages are invited to participate in the 3-position air rifle (3x20). Juniors (as defined by rule 3.1 in the National Standard Air Rifle Rules) will compete in the CMP Cup match for EIC points. Awards will be presented to the top competitors (Precision & Sporter). This is a CMP Cup Match (EIC Points will be given).

SAR – The 60-shot standing match will be open to all ages. Awards will be presented to the top competitors (Precision & Sporter).

AP – The 60-shot standing match will be open to all ages. Awards will be presented to the top competitors.

3PSB 3x20 – Competitors of all ages are invited to participate in the 3-position smallbore (3x20) match. Awards will be presented to the top competitors.

REGISTRATION:

To register, visit <https://olemillrangectc.com/> and look for OMRC Monthly Matches under Upcoming Events. Check sign up genius for the latest relays. **Please be sure to pre-register!** Walk-ons are not guaranteed to be squadded due to space. A late fee of \$5.00 will be assessed for 'Day of Event' registrations.

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FEES:

Each event is \$30. Additional \$25 per team for a Four (4) member team must be declared before the first shot of any team member.

PAYMENT:

Submitted via Sign Up Genius listed on website (www.olemillrangeetc.com)

AWARDS:

Each event (3PAR, SAR, AP, and 3PSB) will award 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place medals provided there are a minimum of five competitors in the event. If there are less than five competitors, only 1st place will be awarded provided there are at least three competitors in the event. For 3PAR and SAR, events will be broken into Sporter and Precision categories. The minimum participation numbers must be met in each category for awards to be presented. Team awards will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place provided there are a minimum of five competing teams. If there are less than five teams, but at least three teams, 1st place will be awarded.

AWARDS WILL BE PRESENTED AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE MATCH

EQUIPMENT:

Athletes will not need spotting scopes. A limited number of shooting mats and kneeling rolls are available for use at the range but athletes are encouraged to bring their own. Air for precision and sporter rifles will be provided. The range has adaptors for Anschutz, FWB, Walther, Avanti, Steyer, and Crossman.

OFFICIAL MATCH PROGRAM

2025 GEORGIA CMP 3PAR STATE CHAMPIONSHIP GA STATE QUALIFIER

LOCATION: Ole Mill Range Complex, 129 N. Searcy Avenue, Griffin, GA 30223

DATE: February 22, 2025 (more relays will be added if needed)

SPONSOR: Georgia Competitive Shooters, Inc.

EVENT: This event is a 4x3x20 team event. Scores fired by each member of a team count for both individual rankings and team rankings. Team scores are calculated by adding the individual scores of the four team members. Times for each position will be 20 minutes for prone, 25 minutes for standing, and 20 minutes for kneeling. Individual competitors are welcome to compete for individual rankings.

ELIGIBILITY: The air rifle match is open to school age competitors per rule 3.1. All school age competitors are welcome regardless of state of residence.

TEAMS: Teams will consist of four athletes from the same school or club. Team members must be declared before any member of the team fires a shot for the match. Competitors not part of a designated 4-person team will compete for individual rankings only. Teams must meet the requirements in rule 3.2 of the National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules. Individuals may not participate on more than one team and may compete in one category only.

QUALIFICATION PROCEDURE: The teams and individuals firing above the cut scores will be invited to attend the CMP National Championship scheduled for June and July. This championship will be held in conjunction with the CMP National 3PAR Championship. Additional qualifiers will be determined through the CMP Regional Championships.

SCHEDULE: 10:00am on Saturday, February 22, 2025 (Additional relays and dates may be added, if needed.)

CLASSES: Sporter and precision air rifle classes per National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules.

RULES: The Current National Standard Three-Position Air Rifle Rules will apply. This is a three-position

CMP state qualifying competition. EIC points for all junior participants, regardless of state of residence, are governed and awarded by current CMP EIC rules.

TARGETS: Events will be conducted on MegaLink electronic targets.

AWARDS: Awards will be provided for the following categories with a minimum of three participants:

- Top three Georgia resident individuals in each junior air rifle class (sporter and precision)
- Overall top Georgia team in each junior air rifle class (sporter and precision)

DIRECTIONS FROM ATLANTA:

Take I-75 South to exit 216 for GA-155/McDonough.

Turn right at GA-155 S/N McDonough Road.

Turn right toward GA-155 S/Jackson Road.

Turn left onto North Searcy Avenue.

Destination is the fenced area on the right.

ENTRY FEES: The registration entry fee is \$25.00 for each individual air rifle competitor. There is no additional team fee.

ENTRIES CLOSE: Entries will be accepted to range capacity. Every effort will be made to accept all competitors who enter. Entries made on the day of competition will be accepted if space is available with an entry fee of \$30.00 per athlete.

CANCELLATIONS: Cancellations received one week in advance, or earlier, will receive a full refund (less \$2 processing fee).
