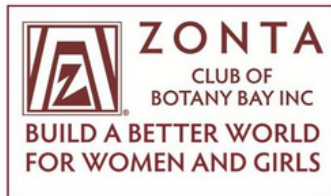
What is coming up at Zonta Botany Bay

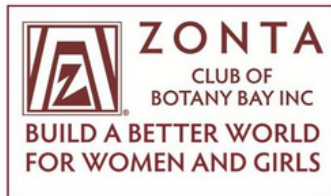

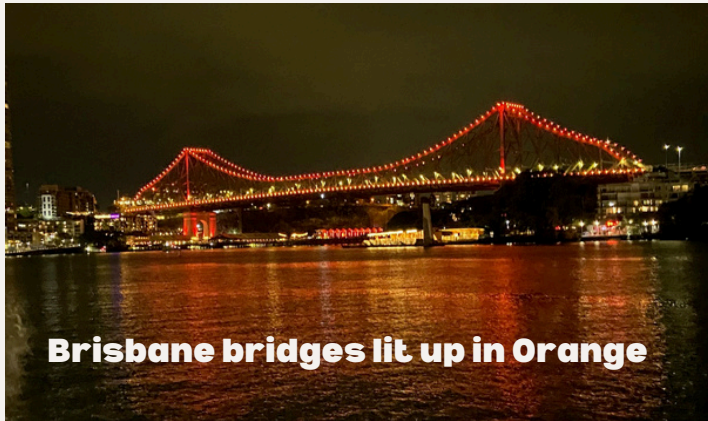

Brisbane bridges lit up in Orange

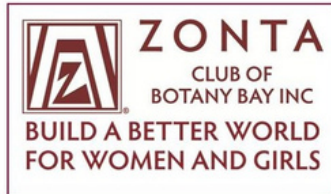


International flags of Zonta Countires

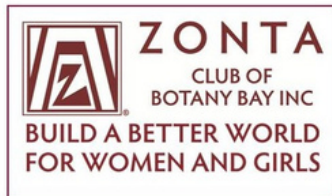

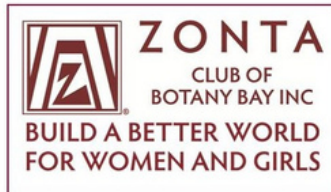
