
COLONY CREEK VILLAGE COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION, INC. ANNUAL MEETING ANNOUNCEMENT & PROXY

Q: What is this form and why is it important?

A: It is a form used to cast your vote as homeowner without attending the annual meeting or it can be used to help establish the quorum without placing a vote. The HOA bylaws require a certain number of homeowners (a quorum) be represented at the meeting or by proxy.


Q : Can I change my vote if I attend the meeting?

A: Yes, if you decide to attend you can request your Proxy be returned and change your vote at the meeting.



Q: How do I fill out the form?


A: Read and select <u>ONE</u> of the three proxy options listed. If you choose option 1 or 3 skip to the signature section. If you select the 2^{nd} option don't forget to vote for or write in someone for each open position.



1. The person you list on the blank line will vote of your behalf. If the line is left blank the HOA president will vote on your behalf. In years the HOA president is up for election the Vice President would vote on your behalf.

- 2. Your Vote will be cast as marked on the Election of Directors section
- 3. No vote will be cast, but you will help establish the required quorum

If you select **OPTION 2** vote for or write in one candiate for each position listed. ("Incumbent" means that the person is currently on the board and running for reelection)



Q: Am I required to provide an address in Colony Creek Village, my name, and signature to complete the proxy? A: Yes, the address, date, printed name, and signature are required to validate your homeowner proxy vote.
