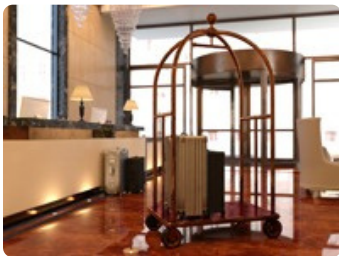
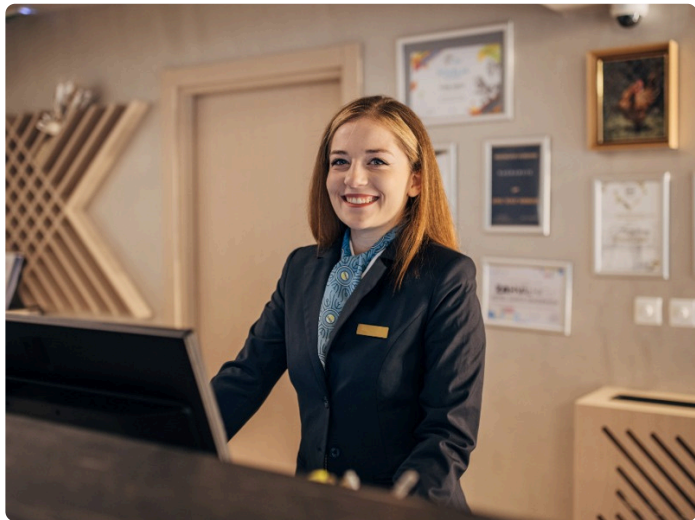
Private Transfer from Cape Town International Airport

Cape of Good Hope & Cape Point and Peninsula Tour

Cape of Good Hope and Cape Point are two of the most famous and popular tourist spots in Cape Town. There is a misconception that the Cape of Good Hope is the most southern tip of Africa, which is not true, as in fact Cape Agulhas is the southernmost point. Both the Cape of Good Hope and Cape Point are sections of the Table Mountain National Park, where you can see cape lions, spotted hyenas, jackals, elephants and zebras.

The full day Peninsula Tour will take you around the entire Cape Peninsula and show you the wonders of Cape Town – from the pristine beaches, to the spectacular sight of Cape Point, where the Atlantic and Indian Oceans meet. View a land based penguin colony at Boulder’s Beach and enjoy the Skywalk at Kirstenbosch Botanical Gardens.

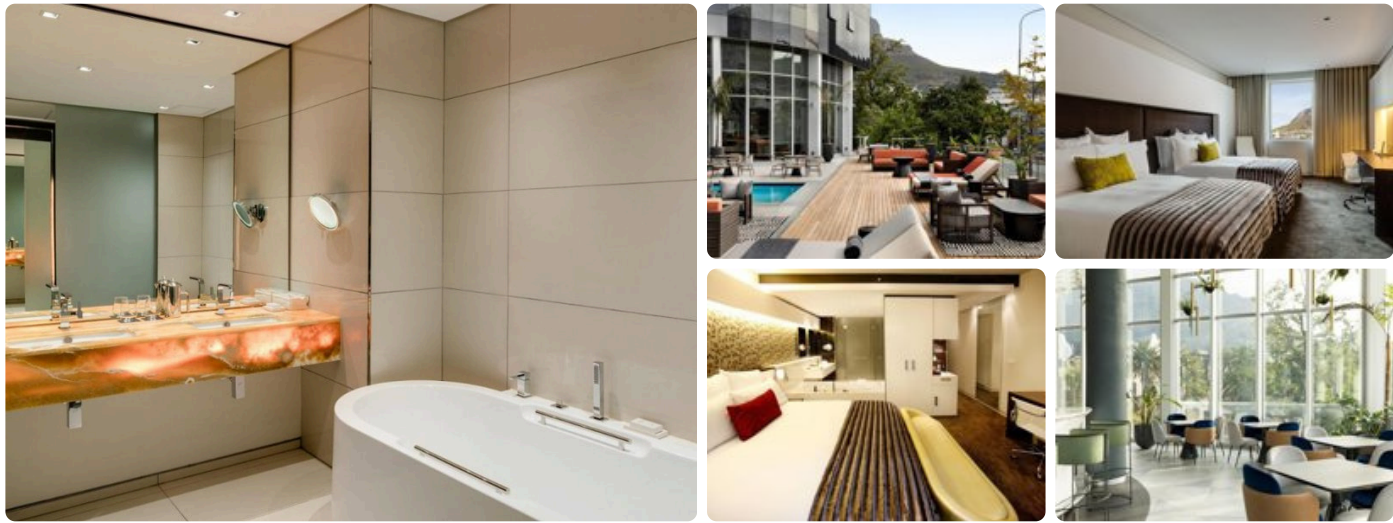

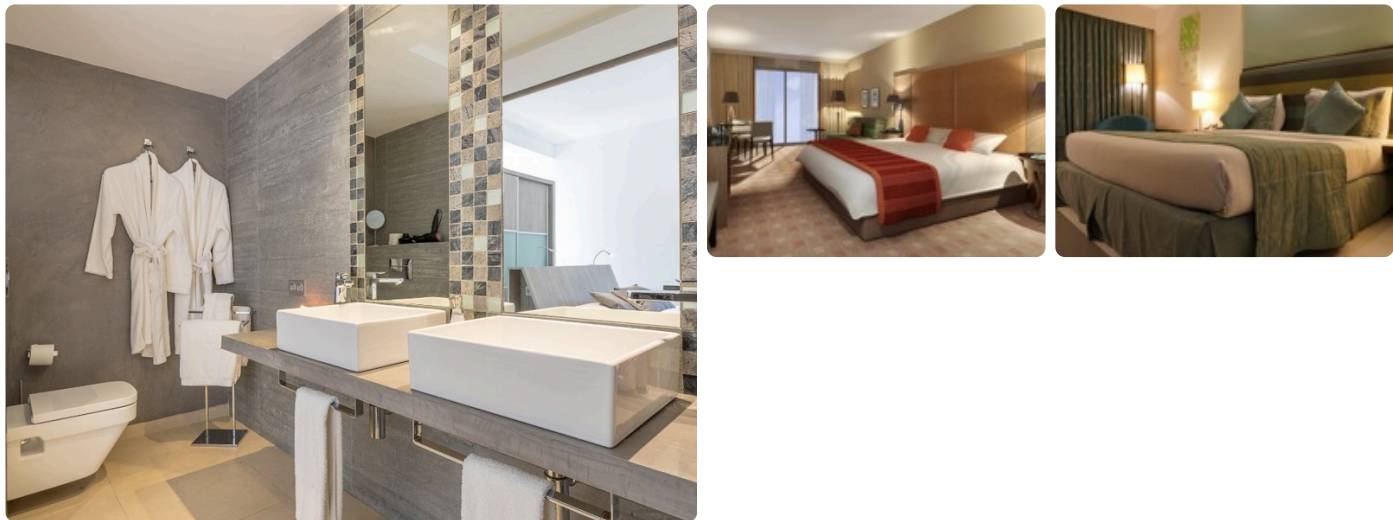


Ostrich Farm in Oudtshoorn

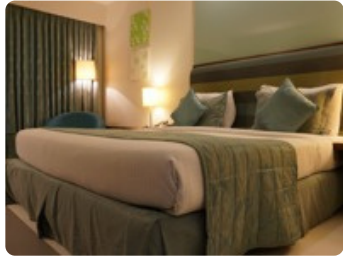
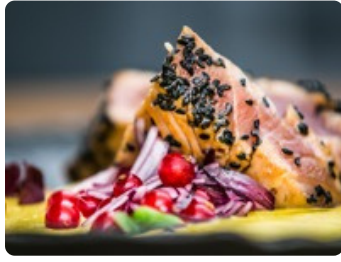


Knysna

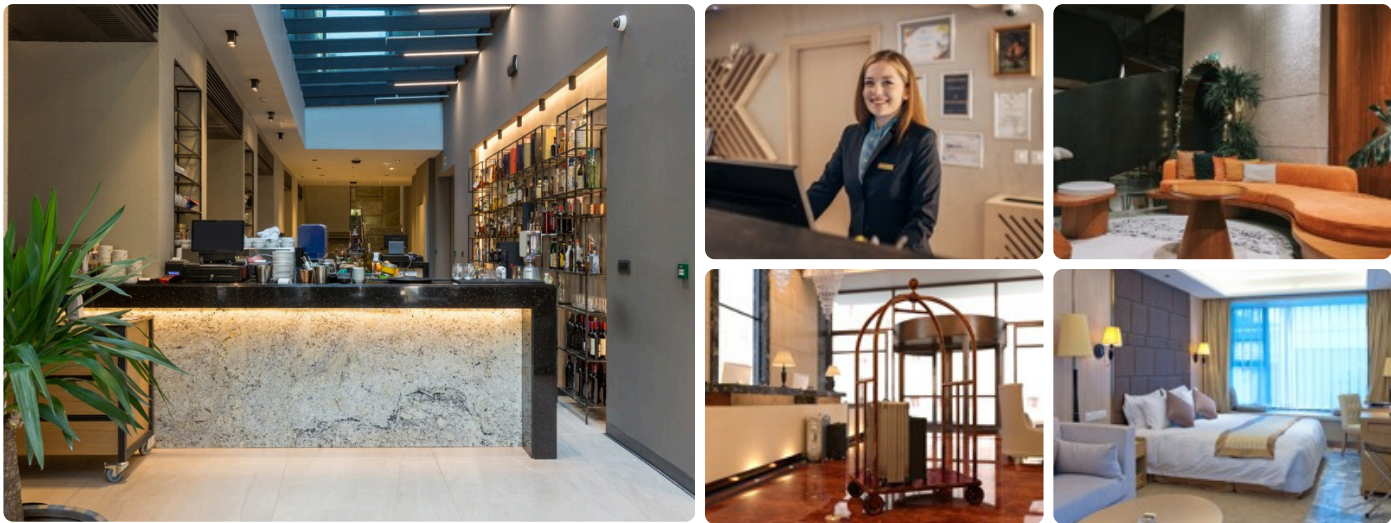

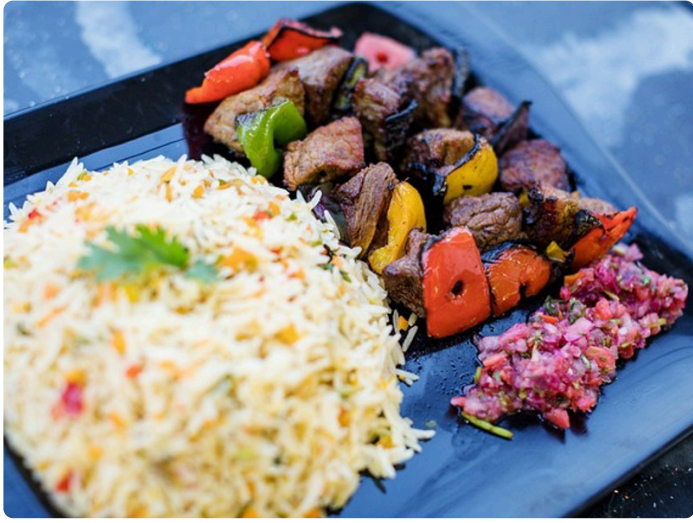
