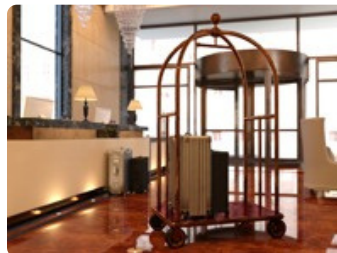
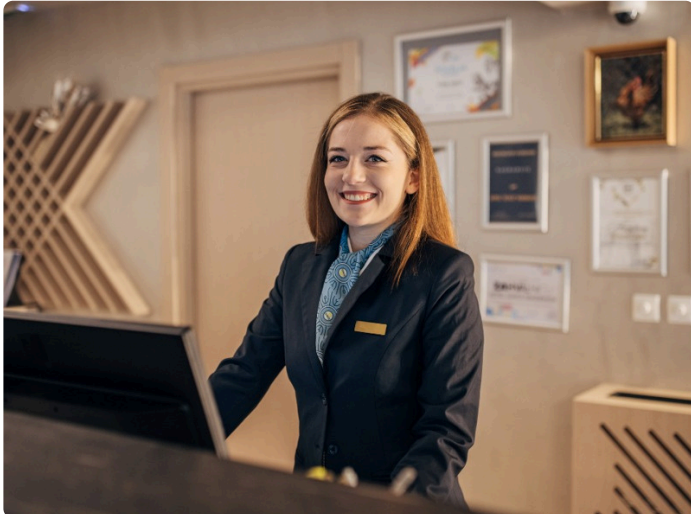
Private Transfer from Cape Town International Airport
