

FOLLOW UP WITH NAVIGATION TO THE  
**OKANOGAN HIGHLANDS LAVENDER FARM**

Please see visual directions below to assist if you are utilizing map or GPS navigation methods. Make the travel to our farm a journey of fun and excitement with turning off your electronic devices and using the natural elements of tree, hills, rocks, mountains, etc. to guide you to a relaxing paradise.



1. Upon arriving in the village by the name of Tonasket you precede down the main street of Tonasket going north on Highway 97, then stay right at the form on the roadway called "Havilla Road".



2. For just about 2,4 miles then you will turn right on Siwash Creek Road. If you count the number of right turns, which you will need to pass prior to, turning onto Siwash Creek Road then Siwash Creek Road will be I believe the 7th road to the right.



3. On Siwash Creek Road you will drive up a large ravine with a canyon on your right side and about 1.9 miles later you will take the first and only major right onto Rhemke Road... This road is important not to miss.

4. Then after driving up the hill on the Rhemke Road for some time you come out on top of the hill from the canyon after crossing a cattle guard and a home on the left you will turn on the second right onto Howell Canyon road drive...

**Note 1:** Howell canyon road is the second right after having turned right on to Rhemke road... The first right is almost immediately after turning on to the Rhemke road and the second right is Howell canyon road.

**Note 2:** when you turn onto Howell canyon road this is where the road turns from gravel county maintained road to a private dirt road.



5. Now you will be driving on Howell canyon road which goes through a wheat field owned by our wonderful neighbors and then you will cross another cattle guard... this is where the Howell Canyon road goes to the right and the Barker Mountain Road turns up the hill to the left...



6. You are traveling to the left up the hill away from Howell canyon road on the GPS identified "Barker Mountain Road"

7. At the top of the hill you will drive through a beautiful pine and fir tree canyon

8. When the road comes out of the canyon you will be coming up out of the trees



9. You need to stay in the middle at the fork, which will lead you to a green gate...  
This is where the Okanogan Highlands Lavender Farm begins.



10. After closing the green gate you will drive for a very short period up hill  
and at this point you now you will be at the beginning of the first lavender fields on the farm.  
Take a Left into the parking lot and find yourself at home.

Remember to always be careful of the wild animals as we need to share this land with them...  
there are badgers, cougars, snakes, bears, etc. in this region of the world so exercise extreme caution  
to not disturb them or become hurt from not paying attention to where you put your feet on the earth.
