The compromise case has been presented before the Tribunal. Petitioners appeared virtually while their Ld. Counsel and Opposite Party No. 3 The TATA AIG General Insurance Company through its Ld. Counsel appeared physically.

A reconciliation between the Petitioners and the O.P. No. 3 has been arrived at and the compromise/settlement paper has been presented before the Tribunal. The photocopy of the Aadhaar card of the Petitioners have also been filed with petition. Compromise/settlement paper 20B has been verified in the presence of the both side. The compromise/settlement paper has been read over and explained to the both parties. As per the terms of the said settlement, O.P. No. 3, The TATA AIG General Insurance Company shall pay ₹6,49,000 (Rupees Six Lakh and Forty Nine Thousand) as compensation to the petitioners in full satisfaction, which the petitioners agree to take. The Settlement 20B has been affirmed before the Tribunal by the bonafide parties. Therefore, the Petition is liable to be decided in full satisfaction accordingly-

## **ORDER**

according to the terms of petition is decided the compromise/settlement paper 20B. Opposite Party No. 3 The TATA AIG General Insurance Company is ordered to deposit the compensation amount of ₹6,49,000 (Rupees Six Lakh and Forty Nine Thousand) to the Accident Claim Tribunal's Canara Bank Account 92352010008560 IFSC- CNRB0019235 through RTGS/NEFT within 30 days. Petitioners shall get 50% compensation amount in their bank account through electronic mode while they shall get 50% in the form of FDR of 3 years each.

The Compromise 20B shall form part of this order. The award be prepared accordingly. The record be consigned as per rules.
