## Misc. Case No. 21A of 2020 Faiyaz Ali v. Raj Kumar & another related MACP No. 527 of 2016

The case is presented before the Tribunal in Virtual Court. Due to the lockdown on the increasing prevalence of COVID 19 virus, Ld. Counsel for Applicant is heard through video conferencing. The applicant Mr. Faiyaz Ali is also present through the video conference.

Perused the record of the MACP No. 527 of 2016 which makes it very clear that on the basis of the compromise between the parties in the National Lok Adalat held on 14/12/2019, a compensation of Rs. 4,60,000 in favor of the applicant Mr. Faiyaz Ali was awarded by M.A.C.T./Additional District Judge (FTC) Jhansi and which was paid by The United India Insurance Company through Cheque No. 8761. As per this Tribunal's office record, whole amount was deposited in the Tribunal's account in Punjab National Bank. This Misc. Case is instituted by the applicant Mr. Faiyaz Ali to get the awarded amount in his account. The affidavit of Mr. Faiyaz Ali is available on the record as per which no appeal has been filed against the award nor is any stay under consideration. Mr. Faiyaz Ali and his Ld. Counsel said that Mr. Faiyaz Ali was award for injuries suffered by him in a motor vehicle accident. He spent huge amount on treatment which has to repay to his creditors. Mr. Faiyaz Ali said that his account is in the UCO Bank and has shared the bank account passbook and a deposit slip through video conferencing stating the Account No. as 00200100005247. According to the award, there is no instruction to deposit the entire amount or any part thereof in FD.

In the light of the above circumstances, I am of the considered view that Rs. 4,60,000 plus interest accrued thereon should be transferred in the account of Mr. Faiyaz Ali through RTGS / NEFT.

## **ORDER**

Punjab National Bank Jhokan Bagh Jhansi is ordered that amount of Rs. 4,60,000 (Four Lakh and Sixty Thousand) awarded to Mr. Faiyaz Ali in the MACP No. 527 of 2016 be transferred in his Account No. 00200100005247 of UCO Bank with interest accrued via RTGS/NEFT mode. Accordingly the case is disposed of in full satisfaction. Record be consigned.
