

Misc. Case No. 63 of 2020 Saheb Singh v. Anil Singh & others related MACP No. 115 of 2018

The case is presented before the Tribunal in Virtual Court. Due to the lockdown on the increasing prevalence of COVID 19, Ld. Counsel for Applicant is heard through video conferencing. The applicant Mr. Saheb Singh is also present on video conference.

Perused the record of the MACP No. 115 of 2018 which makes it very clear that on the basis of merit a compensation of Rs. 8,91,680 with 7% interest in favor of the applicant Mr. Saheb Singh was awarded by M.A.C.T./Additional District Judge (Court No. 3) Jhansi and which was paid by The IFFCO Tokio General Insurance Company through Cheque No. 54967 (HDFC Bank). As per this Tribunal's office record, amount was deposited in the Tribunal's account in Syndicate Bank. This Misc. Case is instituted by the applicant Mr. Saheb Singh to get the awarded amount and interest thereon in his account. The affidavit of Mr. Saheb Singh is available on the record as per which no appeal has been filed against the award nor any stay is granted by the Honb'le High Court. Mr. Saheb Singh and his Ld. Counsel said that Mr. Saheb Singh was award for injuries suffered by him in a motor vehicle accident. He spent huge amount on treatment which has to repay to his creditors. Mr. Saheb Singh stating his Account No. 92352010009055 in the Syndicate Bank, has shared the bank account passbook through video conferencing. The award does not instruct for investment of entire amount or any part thereof in FD.

In the light of the above circumstances, I am of the considered view that Rs. 9,89,770 plus interest accrued thereon in TheTribunal's account should be transferred in the bank account of Mr. Saheb Singh through RTGS / NEFT.

ORDER

Syndicate Bank Jhokan Bagh Jhansi is ordered to transfer amount Rs. 9,89,770 (Nine Lakh Eighty Nine Thousand Seven Hundred Seventy) plus interest of MACP No. 115 of 2018 to Mr. Saheb Singh's Syndicate Bank Account No. 92352010009055 via RTGS/NEFT mode. Accordingly the case is disposed of in full satisfaction. Record be consigned.
