Misc. Case No. 84 of 2020 Mohan Singh and ors. Vs. Suresh Chandra and ors. related MACP No. 152 of 2017

The case was presented before the Tribunal in Virtual Court. Due to the increasing prevalence of COVID-19, Ld. Counsel for applicants is heard through video conferencing. The applicants Pooja, Aryan, Shiv Charan and Shanti were also present on video conference.

Perused the summoned record of the MACP No. 403 of 2017 which makes it clear that on the basis of merit, a compensation of Rs. 3,98,000 with 7% simple annual interest was awarded by MACT/ADJ Jhansi (Court No. 5) in favor of applicants on date 30.08.2019 which was paid by the United India Insurance Company Limited. As per office record, the amount Rs. 4,43,589 have been deposited in the Tribunal's Syndicate Bank account. This Misc. case has been instituted by the applicants in order to get the awarded amount and interest thereon back in their accounts in terms of the award. The affidavit of applicant Mohan Singh in support of release application is available on the record of the Misc. case as per which appeal has been preferred before Honb'le High Court of Judicature at Allahabad by the Insurance Company as FAFO D 61 of 2020 in which following order has been passed—

"On appellant depositing the entire awarded amount before the Tribunal, the execution of the order impugned shall remain stayed. Out of the entire deposited amount, 50% shall be allowed to be withdrawn by claimants and 50% shall be invested in a Fixed Deposit Account-carrying maximum interest for minimum period of three years and the interest on it be paid to claimants."

In the light of the award and order of Honb'le High Court, I am of the view that deposited amount should be disbursed accordingly.

## **ORDER**

Syndicate Bank Jhokan Bagh Jhansi is ordered to disburse deposited amount of MACP No. 152 of 2017 Mohan Singh and ors. Vs. Suresh Chandra and ors. according to the following sheet—
