

Misc. Case No. 925 of 2017 Smt. Aneeta and ors. Vs. UPSRTC and another. related MACP No. 354 of 2017

The case was presented before the Tribunal in Virtual Court. The applicants Aneeta Devi, Km. Ananya, Pooran Lal and Smt. Abda were present on video conference on previous date. Due to the increasing prevalence of COVID-19, I had heard Learned Counsel of the applicants through video conferencing.

Perused the summoned record of the MACP No. 354 of 2017 which makes it clear that on the basis of merit, a compensation of Rs. 9,36,750 with 7% simple interest was awarded by MACT/ADJ Jhansi (Court No. 1) in favor of applicants on date 17.07.2019. As per office report, in compliance of the award amount ₹ 10,54,828 had been paid by the UPSRTC and the amount was deposited in the Tribunal's Syndicate Bank Account. This case has been instituted by the applicants to release the amount and interest thereon in their bank accounts in terms of the award. The affidavit of applicant Aneeta Devi in support of release application is available on the record. As per application appeal was preferred by the OP before Hon'ble High Court Allahabad which is FIRST APPEAL FROM ORDER No. - 2740 of 2019 in which following order has been passed on Date :- 1.10.2019-

"The claimants respondent shall be entitled to withdraw half of the amount, so deposited, without furnishing any security and the remaining amount shall be invested by the Tribunal in any nationalized bank providing higher interest thereon.

"The apportionment of the amount, to be paid to the claimants, shall be made in same proportion as directed in the award passed by the Tribunal."

This case has been instituted by the applicants to release the amount and interest thereon in their bank accounts in terms of the above order of the Hon'ble High Court.

In the light of the above, I am of the view that deposited amount should be disbursed accordingly.

ORDER

Syndicate Bank Jhokan Bagh Jhansi is ordered to disburse deposited amount of **MACP No. 354 of 2017 Smt. Aneeta and ors. Vs. UPSRTC and another** according to the following sheet-
