Officers Sign Conflict of Interest Policy: we need something in place for applying for grants. Officers signed appropriate documentation.

Village Store:

Generator – There is a deposit, the generator will be installed July 21st. Mike Aron will be meeting with Irving, who will provide two propane tanks. The electrical panel will be given a small upgrade at that time in the cellar. Rick mentioned he can get a substantial fuel discount, so Ann suggested Rick talk with Mike Aron. Rick said three or four tanks will be needed if we install propane heat to replace the present oil burner that is in the cellar. Inspections would be free. Ann said the present propane tank has passed inspection.

The Store received a grant from the ACCT for a pizza oven, which Skeet Pelletier is working on.

OSHA was called because the store was apparently too hot. Ann ordered industrial fans and an air conditioner to remedy the situation. She called OSHA to work through the problem.

She contacted a person to fix the screened door at the front of the store entrance. She would like to upgrade the floor in the kitchen, and will investigate. Due to a staffing issue, the store will be closing at 3 PM weekdays. Lorrie asked if the horseshoe pit could be mentioned on the Store and AHS FaceBook posts? Yes.

Do we want solar power? Helen is restarting the process of applying for the federal grant and needs to know. Ann says yes, if it will help with bills. Lindley has information for a company who supplies this. Ann asks do we need an array in the field, or is the roof sufficient? Information gathering to follow.

Roof: Helen talked with Mary Lord on Saturday. Will the roof be done this year? Bret has other obligations. Marianne: Is it historical to place a metal roof on the store? Helen said it wouldn't matter. Jim brought up fire extinguishers. Ann stated they have passed inspections. Helen has quotes for a sprinkler system.. It would need an additional tank for this. Do we need another pump? Water is another issue for the store, because the well is located under the store driveway.

Portapotty: the store doesn't have plans for many events this summer, should we keep it? Alison will call to have it picked up.

Turnaround Barn rental- Ann: Eric Wilke rented the barn, and said there should be more events. Alison will put publicity out on our website.
