



FUTURITY RULES:

- 1) Futurity to be governed by 2021 ApHC rulebook.
- 2) Scores of all judges will be combined.
- 3) Ties will be broken by a predetermined call judge.
- 4) 80% of all entry fees to be included in purse.
- 5) Entries must be received by due date. Postmarks are not acceptable.
- 6) Entries may be paid by debit or credit cards and may be pre-authorized.
- 7) Entries will be required to pay daily haul-in fee or overnight stabling fee.
- 8) No refunds or substitutions allowed.
- 9) Trifecta calculated from the scores of the entered regular age-appropriate classes for Halter, In Hand Trail, and Longeline. You must also enter the Trifecta futurity.

Each horse entered will be required to pay an office fee. If you haul in, you will need to pay any grounds fees. If you stall your horse, the ground fee is waived, and you will be responsible for a stall fee in addition to your entry fee.

Spotted Spring Spectacular May 14-16, 2021 Rules/Notes For Exhibitors

- 1. All Breeds, Appaloosas, and POAC to show in the same class at the same time, and results for each approving breed organization will be produced separately. Classes that are only open to ApHC horses are clearly marked on the class list.
- 2. Show management must inspect all ApHC and POAC certificates of registration on the horses to be shown for breed points.
- 3. If showing for ApHC or POAC breed points. Exhibitors, horse owners, and lessees must hold current 2021 membership with the breed organization. If you cannot produce a current membership card you will need to purchase another membership at the show BEFORE you can show.
- 4. Youth, Amateur/19&Over, and Non-Pro Walk-Trot may not cross enter into any of the 3 gaited classes at the same show. You may enter the All Breed Walk Trot Class as it is designed as a warm up class.
- 5. Ranch Horse Exhibitors/Horses: You must show in 1 under saddle ranch class to enter the ranch horse confirmation class.
- 6. Saddle Pleasure Type ie: Arabian, Saddlebred, Tennessee Walker, etc.
- 7. Stock Hunter Type- Appaloosa, Quarter Horse, Paint, etc..
- 8. Colored Horse Must show visible color.
- 9. Novice All Breed Classes- not to have won 3, 1st places in that division or be in your first year of showing.
- 10. All out of state equine must have a current coggins and health certificate (within 30 days) in their possession per Oregon State Law.
- 11. Only one horse/one rider combination are eligible to compete for high point awards.
- 12. This show is governed by ApHC and POAC Rules.
- 13. Show Management reserves the right to dismiss any exhibitor or owner from the show and grounds for any abuse of an equine. Refunds will not be given in this case.
- 14. Refunds are only available with show management approval or a valid vet certificate.
- 15. Dogs must be under control and kept on a leash at all times. Failure to obey this rule can result in a citation.
- 16. Stalls are provided with initial bedding only. Additional bedding is available in bulk for a small fee per load.
- 17. Placings are 1st thru 6th, Placings in Youth Classes are 1st thru 8th.
- 18. Youth must wear a helmet in all gaming events!
