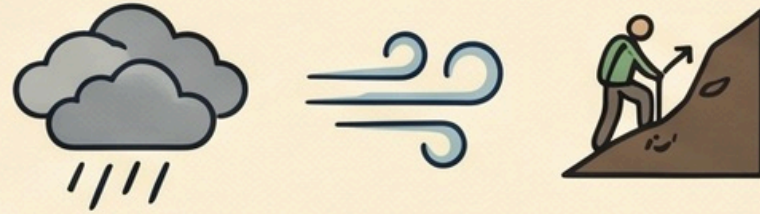


CONDITION:
Light Rain / Light Wind
(Sustained winds < 10 m/s)

RISKS:
Standard wet-weather alpine hiking. Volcanic trails remain stable during the climb.

ACTION:
Climb proceeds. Full technical waterproof outerwear recommended.

MONITOR



CONDITION:
Heavy Rain / Moderate Wind
(Sustained winds 10-16.5 m/s)

RISKS:
Decreased visibility, slippery volcanic scree, and an increased risk of hypothermia on the ascent or descent.

ACTION:
Pacing is adjusted to increased degree of group management. Safety checks frequency increased.

NO-GO

(Mandatory Cancel/Turnaround)



CONDITION:
Typhoon Warnings / Lightning / High Winds
(Sustained winds > 16.5 m/s at the summit)

RISKS:
Severe risk of being blown off balance, rockfall hazards, zero-visibility whiteouts, and high hypothermia danger.

ACTION:
Climb is delayed, cancelled, or the Lead Guide exercises absolute authority to turn the group around. Office notified immediately.
