Opening:

(Kiss the crucifix and silently state intentions)

*In nomine Patris, et Filii, et Spiritus Sancti. Amen.

1. Credo Credo in Deum, Patrem omnipotentem, Creatorem caeli et terrae. Et in Iesum Christum, Filium eius unicum, Dominum nostrum, qui conceptus est de Spiritu Sancto, natus ex Maria Virgine, passus sub Pontio Pilato, crucifixus, mortuus, et sepultus; descendit ad inferos; tertia die resurrexit a mortuis; ascendit ad caelos; sedet ad dexteram Dei Patris omnipotentis; inde venturus est iudicare vivos et mortuos. Credo in Spiritum Sanctum, sanctam Ecclesiam catholicam, sanctorum communionem, remissionem peccatorum, carnis resurrectionem, vitam aeternam. Amen.

2. Pater Noster

Pater noster, qui es in caelis, sanctificetur nomen tuum; adveniat regnum tuum; fiat voluntas tua, sicut in caelo et in terra. Panem nostrum quotidianum da nobis hodie; et dimitte nobis debita nostra, sicut et nos dimittimus debitoribus nostris; et ne nos inducas in tentationem; sed libera nos a malo. Amen.

3. Ave Maria (x3) - (x10)

Ave Maria, gratia plena, Dominus tecum; benedicta tu in mulieribus, et benedictus fructus ventris tui, Iesus. Sancta Maria, Mater Dei, ora pro nobis peccatoribus, nunc et in hora mortis nostrae. Amen.

Gloria Patri (Orange Beads)

Gloria Patri, et Filio, et Spiritui Sancto. Sicut erat in principio, et nunc, et semper, et in saecula saeculorum. Amen.

Fatima Prayer

O mi Iesu, dimitte nobis debita nostra, libera nos ab igne inferni, perduc in caelum omnes animas, praesertim illas quae maxime indigent misericordia tua.

Joyful (Mon & Thurs)

1. The Annunciation – The Angel Gabriel announces to the Blessed Virgin Mary that she shall conceive the Son of God.

2. The Visitation – The Blessed Virgin Mary visits her cousin Saint Elizabeth.

3. The Nativity – Our Lord Jesus Christ is born in Bethlehem.

4. The Presentation – The Blessed Virgin Mary presents the Child Jesus in the Temple.

5. The Temple – The Child Jesus is found in the Temple among the doctors.

Sorrowful (Tue & Fri)

1. The Agony – Our Lord prays in the Garden of Gethsemane and sweats blood.

2. The Scourging – Our Lord is scourged at the pillar.

3. The Crowning – Our Lord is crowned with thorns.

4. The Carrying of the Cross – Our Lord carries His Cross to Calvary.

5. The Crucifixion – Our Lord is crucified and dies on the Cross.

Glorious (Wed, Sat & Sun)

1. The Resurrection – Our Lord rises from the dead.

2. The Ascension – Our Lord ascends into Heaven.

3. The Descent of the Holy Spirit – The Holy Ghost descends upon the Apostles.

4. The Assumption – The Blessed Virgin Mary is assumed into Heaven.

5. The Coronation – The Blessed Virgin Mary is crowned Queen of Heaven.
