Volunteer Opportunities

There are several opportunities to help. We would suggest 4 hour shifts. The Festival hours are Saturday, 9-5 and Sunday, 10-4. Shifts can be altered to work with volunteer's schedule but we would like to have help during the following times:

Saturday, (Parking) 8:30-12:30,11:00-3:00, (Bus Drop Off Greeters) 8:30-12:30, 11:00-3:00, (Bus Pickup) 9:30-1:30, 12:00-4:00, (Hospitality / Entertainment Area Greeters) 9:00-1:00, 12:30-4:30

Sunday, (Parking) 9:30-1:30, 12:00-4:00, (Bus Drop Off Greeters) 9:30-1:30, 12:00-4:00, (Bus

In all areas you should wear comfortable clothing and shoes. Also you may want to wear a hatand sunscreen. We will provide water and drinks and a festival t-shirt.

Below is a brief description of the areas and what you would be doing.

<u>Setup</u>

We start setting up on Friday before the festival. There are always lots of small jobs that need to be done such as distributing rolling trash containers, sweeping out sheds and putting table clothes on tables in large shed, help vendors with setup, just to name a few items. You will bewalking a lot, but will not be in the sun so much.

Parking

There are several parking lots. Two grass parking lots where attendees to the festival park their cars, also a handicap parking lot that is a black top lot, and VIP and crafters parking lotsare located in the park and are grass lots

Volunteers would be asked to help direct cars once they are in the grass parking lots. Also at the attendees lots you may be asked to help people load and unload the buses. This is mostlystanding and you will be in the sun. Tents are provided in the parking areas for shade.
