




Install Syncthing-Fork for Android 5.0+ from one of these stores.

Enable permissions





Go to the Devices tab, click on add device to add the MGDT Upload Server




Scan or paste in the MGDT Upload Server Id. Enter a Name for it "MGDT Upload Server"

The MGDT Upload server device Id is



In Syncthing-Fork on Android go to the Folder tabs, add a folder, give the sync a name, select the folder on the device to Sync, choose the device you want to sync it to, Folder Type, select Sync Only, Enable Watch for changes, set Sync condition if it should run only when on Wi-Fi or on mobile data too and if when on AC and battery or just one or the other. And Select accept.




Go to the Status Tab and see if Syncthing-fork is running or not. If not, it might say why, like that's it's not configured to run on mobile data and the Wi-Fi is not available, etc.



Contact customer support to activate the folder sync on the MGDТ Upload server.

Provide them your DeviceID and Folder name.

When it is activated, you should see an “Up to Date” status like this.



Repeat for any other folders or devices.
