


Creating an account on the website.

To create an account on the MGDT website, go to <https://mgdt.azurewebsites.net/> and click on “Sign in/Sign up” in the top right corner of the screen.

Click on the “Sign up now” link at the bottom of the screen

- Enter your email address
- Enter the Captcha characters
- Click the Send verification code.
- Get the code in the email you will receive, and put it in the Verification Code box, click on the “Verify Code” button.
- Fill out your password and again for confirmation
- Fill out your Given Name, Surname and Display Name
- Click on Create.

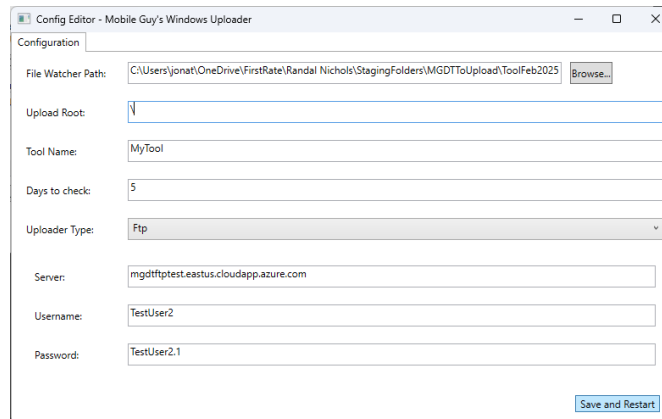
Create a subscription

Once you've created an account on the website and created your settings, you can create a subscription to activate your accounts. The Stripe subscription comes with a 30-day free trial, which you can cancel at any time. You won't be charged until the end of the free trial, then once monthly at the end of each period. You will have a link to log into the Stripe portal and change your subscription settings.

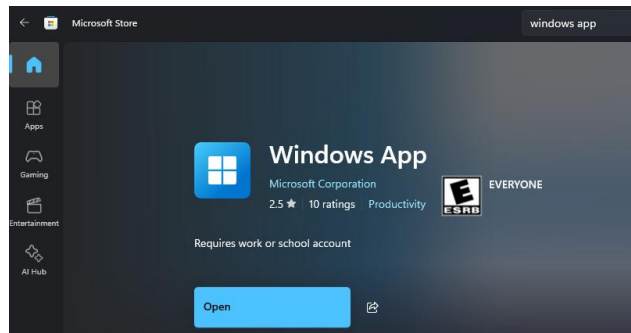


Uploading files via FTP

Opening the Remote App

Log into the MGD Online remote app with in Azure Virtual Desktop by means of the “Windows App” app from the Windows app store. On windows, it will be like you are working on your local computer even though everything is in the cloud.

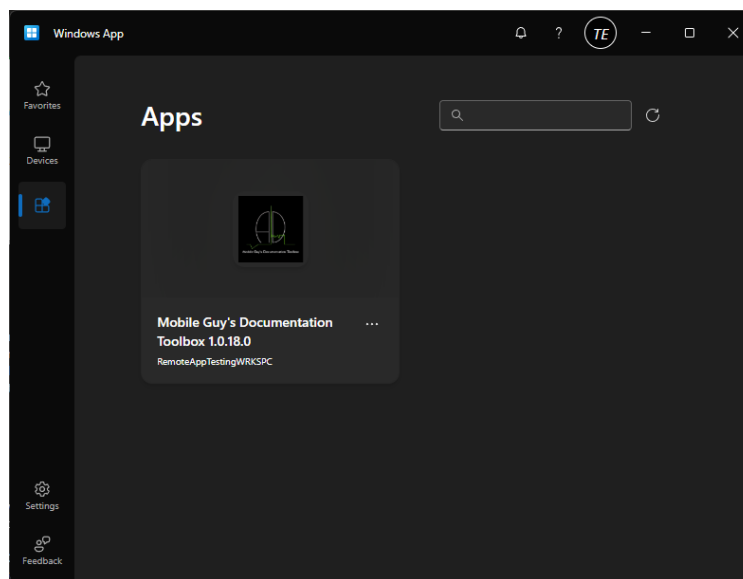

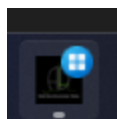

It will open in a window and look like it’s running on your computer. The icon in the taskbar will look like



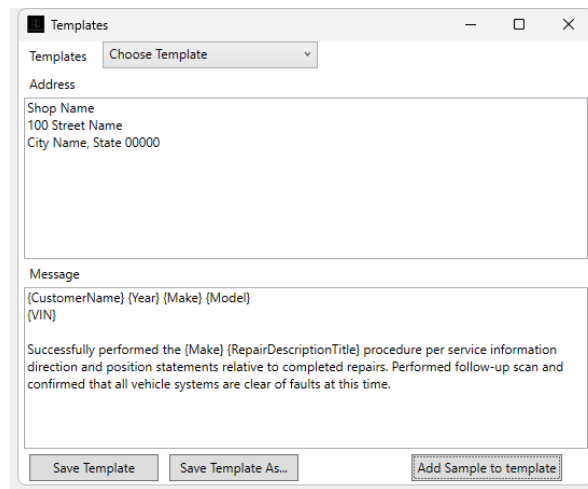
Setting up MGDT App configuration for the first time

General use of MGDT application

The last month of files will be in the Desktop Uploads folder. Any files older than one month old will be automatically removed from this folder.

I've added a quick Sample button for the templates as they will be empty when a new user signs into to a new account.



When the report folder opens it can be copied then pasted into a File Explorer on the local computer. Because the file Explorer that opens belongs to the Virtual machine in the cloud even though it looks like it's local. The users' computer drives are also mapped so they could also open them there and paste them there as well if they want to pin a Favorite to a directory on their own computer.
