CCR POA ROAD REPORT

ROAD REPORT: Shawn Miller, Road Committee Chair/Member

- I. On Saturday, September 13, 2025, a volunteer crew patched potholes on Black Peak Rd. Total cost: approximately \$200.00.
- **II.** Washout on Feather Canyon: Denton Kline and Shawn Miller volunteered to supply materials and equipment at **no charge** to effect needed repairs.
- **III.** Road Committee is currently finalizing plans for concrete work on Black Peak Rd. entailing the following:
 - A. Volunteers;
 - B. Schedules of Volunteer availability;
 - C. Exact square footage, considering available funds after road blading and granite installation has been reviewed and approved.

- IV. Request for Proposals have been sent out and bids have been received for the following:
 - A. Blading of all roads;
 - **B.** Adding material(s) to the dirt-side of Black Peak Rd.;
 - C. Installing material(s) from where Copper Canyon Drive comes out of John Moore Wash to Breezy Hill.

**NOTES: per prior Road Report:

- 1. Black Peak chip and seal section is approximately 950 feet long.
- 2. Top 320 feet can be returned to natural material due to relatively low angle.
- 3. Several hundred feet of the bottom of Black Peak are still in relatively good shape.
- 4. Replace worst 20 ft wide strips yearly.
- 5. Best time to schedule the work would be between November 8th to November 17th. Demo asphalt and prep for concrete on Saturday, pour concrete on the following Monday.
