## Road Committee Report 2025-01-16

The roads are in bad shape and need immediate attention.

- Capping the roads with granite. 2 bids from Dixon and CMS were considered. 2 NO bids were received. CMS bid was accepted by unanimous vote of the Board for \$71,469.68
  - 1. Omega: 700 tons, 4000 gallons of Water, Blading 1000ft
  - 2. Copper Canyon & Blue Jay 700 tons, 4000 gallons of Water, Blading 1000ft
  - 3. Copper Canyon & Wilson Hill. 680 tons, 4000 gallons of Water, Blading 800ft
- CMS donated TIME & MATERIALS
- The culverts need to be cleared to prevent flooding, and a scope of work should be sent out to locals. Old culverts could be reused. A road grader could be used to clear the culverts, but it would be costly. Cleaning the culverts has been attempted before, but heavy rains quickly block them again.
- Mountainside needs a couple of culverts to prevent flooding
