6.04 <u>Inoperable Vehicles and Equipment</u>. The 100-foot side and rear yard setback shall not be used for repair or storage of inoperable motor vehicles or equipment; nor shall there be permitted the repair or storage of more than <u>ONE (1)</u> unregistered, inoperable motor vehicle within the property boundaries

SUBURBAN RANCH

2. d. Required front and street side yard setbacks shall not be used for the repair or storage of inoperable motor vehicles, nor shall operable or inoperable vehicles be parked or stored in such a manner as to restrict the view of motorists entering a street from an alley, side street or driveway; nor shall there be permitted the repair or storage of more than one unregistered, inoperable motor vehicle within the property boundaries.

GILA COUNTY:

Only ONE (1) unregistered, inoperable motor vehicle within the property boundaries

SYNOPSIS:

Inoperable Vehicles and Equipment:

- The 100-foot side and rear setback shall not be used to store or repair inoperable vehicles/equipment.
- Not more than one inoperable/unregistered vehicle within property boundaries.
