

BY-LAWS

MARION COUNTY AEROSPACE FOUNDATION, INC.

A. MEETINGS:

1. Meetings of the general membership will be held four (4) times yearly.
2. Meetings of the Board of Directors will be held every four months.
3. Special meetings of the Board of Directors may be called as necessary by action of the Executive Committee or the general membership.
4. Executive Committee meetings will be held monthly.

B. PRINCIPAL OFFICE:

The principal office of the MCAF shall be 2439 S.E. 35th Street, Ocala, Florida 32671.

C. TERM OF MEMBERSHIP

1. Associate Membership - one year, three years or life memberships.
2. General Membership - one year, three years or life memberships.
3. Honorary Membership - as recommended by the Executive Committee and authorized by the Board of Directors.

D. FELLOWSHIPS

A fellowship is an honorarium bestowed upon an individual or corporation and named the "Aerospace Exploration Fellowship". It is purchased by an individual or corporation and awarded to an individual or corporation of their choice. A plaque is given to the Fellowship recipient and also will be recorded in a place of recognition at Marion County Aerospace Foundation headquarters.

F. COMMITTEES

1. The following committees are established. These committees are expected to hold regular meetings. Committee members must be general members of MCAF in good standing. Standing committees are established with a definite term consistent with the normal business year of the Association. These committees shall deal with continuing purposes of the Association. Their responsibilities are defined in Article V, paragraph (h), (1) of the constitution. The Chairperson of each standing committee shall be appointed from the Directors of the MCAF Board of Directors.

A. Aerospace Education Committee. A minimum of three. This committee is responsible for the promotion of aviation and aerospace to the general public and local educators. Aerospace education of youth shall be a primary goal. The committee shall meet, at least, quarterly.

B. Aircraft Operations Committee. A minimum of four. All members of this committee shall hold a pilots certificate and have current knowledge of aircraft operations. This committee shall meet, at least, quarterly and address issues of concern to airport operations.

C. Special Activities Committee. A committee consisting of a minimum of three. The chairman shall also be the editor of the Foundation's periodic informational newsletter. Responsibilities of this committee shall be, but limited to:

- * Flying Safety Award
- * Aerospace Education Award
