What's New YouTube Video of Erin's Angels

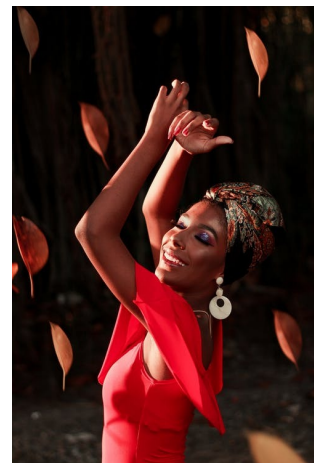
New Video! Erin's Angels is a Not-For-Profit organization that makes sure no child goes hungry. Our school system had to face this tragedy in 2008. A young girl was starved and sexually abused by family members and died. She was 11. As adults, we were not prepared to understand what was going on, but we

should have. It cost this child her life. Children shouldn't have to ever worry about feeding themselves. Food insecurity is the premise of this video and a call to help is included. We can't ignore any signal that a child is in trouble. I donated this video to Sheila Dion, Erin's Angels founder in hope that people will take child hunger seriously and do something to help.

Flamenca Poetry
