May God bless you and your family with peace and love during this Christmas Season and in the New Year!!



# Electronic Giving Through SQUARE



The Board approved the use of Square as an electronic option to accept tithes and offerings. The system has been operational for a few weeks now. We've had a few volunteers to test the site with great success! You will be able to donate on the website which was free to the church or via the app. We also plan to make the QR code available for quick access. You will receive an email confirmation once your donation has been received. Here

are some basic Q & A to provide more information.

How much does it cost?

2.9% + \$0.30 per transaction

What credit cards can be accepted?

Visa, MC, Discover, American Express, Apple Pay and Google Pay

How does FCC get the money?

Directly deposited into the church's bank account, into the general fund

Does it track who donated?

Transactions are tracked by card number and transaction date

Electronic giving is a great option if you are going to miss a Sunday, be on vacation, or just forgot the checkbook! The site gives you the option of selecting a fixed dollar amount or entering in a specific amount. Here is a look at the website and the link to our FCC account.
