

The Bible says the early Christians devoted themselves to prayer together (Acts 2:42). There are examples of them meeting in people's homes and praying, and the Holy Spirit working in a mighty way (Acts 4:23-35). This kind of praying together is exactly what we're practicing on Wednesday night.
