Even in the first century the Apostle Paul was flexible with his methods to pass on the unchanging message. 1 Corinthians 9:22 he writes "To the weak I became weak, to win the weak. So, won't you be patient as we are making repairs and improvements? For a while it may be a little inconvenient, but the end result will be well worth the wait. When it's finally done, just like the parsonage, we will all be rejoicing at how well it looks.


