Jesus Is All You Need

What would the apostle Paul say to Americans today? I suspect it might be something like what he said in Acts 17:1 "I see that in every way you are very religious." Being religious is not enough. One of the most destructive religious ideas that has infected our culture is that all you need is a little Jesus. People like to mention Jesus. They like to post things about Jesus on social me-

dia. Maybe others are saying things about loving Jesus and loving others. But the mistaken idea is that we can live our lives and add just a little Jesus on top. If you sprinkle a little Jesus in your life, you're going to be fine. Pursue your happiness plan your life, be busy setting your financial goals and add some Jesus in occasionally; some church and occasional prayer and Bible reading. Live your life the way you want; just add some Jesus and you will have a happy life.

This is what the false teachers were teaching to the church at Colossae. For the next two months we're going to be studying Colossians, with the theme that Jesus is all you need. As we were reminded in our study in Jude the church exists to make and grow followers of Jesus. Our study in Colossians is going to be about deepening our roots. Not just a little Jesus, but letting our relationship with Jesus and the Holy Spirit living in us permeate through every area of our life. A key scripture for the study is Colossians 2:6,7 "So then, just as you received Christ Jesus as Lord, continue to live your lives in Him, rooted and built up in Him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught, and overflowing with thankfulness."

I hope you are ready to not only grow with new people being reached with the gospel, but also growing and rooting yourself into Christ. May this challenge each of us to not be comfortable with "just a little Jesus".

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CWF HAPPENINGS



Electronic Giving Through SQUARE



The Board approved the use of Square as an electronic option to accept tithes and offerings. The system has been operational for a few weeks now. We've had a few volunteers to test the site with great success! You will be able to donate on the website which was free to the church or via the app. We also plan to make the QR code available for quick access. You will receive an email confirmation once your donation has been received. Here

are some basic Q & A to provide more information.

How much does it cost?

2.9% + \$0.30 per transaction

What credit cards can be accepted?

Visa, MC, Discover, American Express, Apple Pay and Google Pay

How does FCC get the money?

Directly deposited into the church's bank account, into the general fund

Does it track who donated?

Transactions are tracked by card number and transaction date

Electronic giving is a great option if you are going to miss a Sunday, be on vacation, or just forgot the checkbook! The site gives you the option of selecting a fixed dollar amount or entering in a specific amount. Here is a look at the website and the link to our FCC account.
