In accordance with the provisions of Section 17A of Chapter 85 of the Massachusetts General Laws, you must conduct such solicitation under the conditions and guidelines hereto attached:

- The solicitation shall be limited to one (1) day and shall be conducted during daylight hours only.
- No person under the age of sixteen (16) years shall enter the public way for any reason.
- Clearly marked signs, easily visible from motor vehicles, shall be placed at each location and shall include the name of the organization conducting the solicitations and the charity for which donations are being collected.
- Persons actively soliciting contributions shall wear some form of identification; e.g. uniform, badges, nameplate, etc., which would identify him of her as a member of the sponsoring organization.
- Persons soliciting contributions shall wear American National Safety Institute (ANSI) approved hi-visibility
 outerwear and shall approach only those vehicles already stopped in traffic. Solicitors shall not cause
 vehicles to stop or park in any manner contrary to the directions of traffic control signals present, or in
 violation of existing rules and regulations. While traffic is moving solicitors shall remain on the sidewalk,
 shoulder or safety island until vehicles come to a complete stop.
- Cones or other safety devices shall be utilized by solicitors to help create a high visibility safety zone.
- If traffic begins to stall or back up, persons collecting contributions shall suspend solicitations until the traffic flow has returned to normal.
- If there is inclement weather, wet roads, or poor visibility this permit will be voided.

Please submit your application along with your \$2.00 fee to Liz Martinsen, Records Clerk, so we may schedule your fundraiser date. We will contact you when your permit is approved and when you may pick up your permit.

The preceding rules and regulations have been established by the Auburn Police Department and must be strictly adhered to. Failure to comply may result in the immediate revocation of the permit.
