

Immediately after reciting this bracha we will recite the bracha:

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה ה' אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם שֶׁחֲלַק מִהַכְמָתוֹ לִירֵאָיו
Baruch Ata Adonai, Eloheinu Melech HaOlam, She'chalak
Meichachmoso li'rei'av

Blessed are You Hashem, King of the universe, Who has given
from His wisdom to those who fear Him.

When one actually sees Moshiach, one should recite:

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה ה' אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם שֶׁהֵחֵינוּ וְקִיַּמְנוּ וְהִיָּשְׁנוּ לְזִמְנוּ הַזֶּה
Baruch Ata Adonoy, Eloheinu Melech HaOlam,
Sheh-heh-che-yanu, v'ki-yi-ma-nu, v'hi-gi-ya-nu, la'zman ha-zeh
Blessed are You Hashem, our G-D, King of the universe, Who
has given us life, and Who has sustained us, and Who has
allowed us to reach this day.

*On the anniversary of Moshiach's arrival, we will once again recite
sheh-heh-che-yanu to commentate the date, and we will recite a
long bracha mentioning some of the details of the miraculous events
of his arrival.*

The bracha will close with the words:

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה ה' אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם גָּאֹל וְשׂוֹאֵל
Baruch Ata Adonai, Ga-al Yisroel
Blessed are You, Hashem, Who redeems Israel

*If you are sharing this card with someone who came back from the
dead, they should say:*

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה ה' אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם מְחַיֶּה הַמֵּתִים
Baruch Ata Adonai, Eloheinu Melech HaOlam, me-cha-yay
may-sim

Blessed are You Hashem, our G-D, Master if the universe who
resurrects the dead.

*When we first hear from a reliable source the good news of
Moshiach's arrival, we will recite:*

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה ה' אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם הַטּוֹב וְהַמֵּיֻשִּׁיב
Ba-ruch Ata Adonai, Eloheinu Melech HaOlam, HaTov
V'HaMeiteiv

Blessed are You, Hashem, our G-D, King of the universe, Who
does good and makes even better.

*When we see the huge throngs of Jews assembled to greet him, at
least 600,000 people, one recites:*

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה ה' אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם הַכֹּסֵם הַרְוִים
Baruch Ata Adonai, Eloheinu Melech HaOlam, Chacham
Harazim

Blessed are You, Hashem, our G-D, King of the universe, The
wise One who knows all secrets.

*When one sees the rebuilt Beis HaMikdash or rebuilt Shuls or Batei
Medrash, one recites:*

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה ה' אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם מְצִיב גְּבוּל אֶלְמָנָה
Baruch Ata Adonai, Eloheinu Melech HaOlam, Matziv Gvul
Almanah

Blessed are You Hashem, our G-D, King of the universe,
Returning the widow to her property.

When we actually see the Moshiach, we will recite:

בְּרוּךְ אַתָּה ה' אֱלֹהֵינוּ מֶלֶךְ הָעוֹלָם שֶׁחֲלַק מִכְבוֹדוֹ לִירֵאָיו
Baruch Ata Adonai, Eloheinu Melech HaOlam, She'chalak
Mikevodo Li'rei'av

Blessed are You Hashem, our G-D, King of the universe, Who
has given from His honor to those who fear Him.
