We're teaming up to grow **1,000 tonnes** of brown onions and turn them into a unique, high-quality onion sauce — a product with no real equivalent in the Southeast Asia region.

This is more than a crop. It's a vertically integrated supply chain that delivers real commercial returns while building stronger regional communities.

- Encourages young people to stay in farming
