Castle Rock Pinot Noir,
California \$10/\$32

A classic pinot noir with notes of cherry, spice, cola and fleshy strawberry. A hint of earth and toasty oak round out the finish.

Ken Wright Pinot Noir,
Willamette, Oregon \$44

A full bodied wine, with complex structure and surprising notes of red berries, eucalyptus, spice and black pepper.

Catena Cabernet, Mendoza,
Argentina \$12/\$38

Juicy black plum and cassis, spicy notes of pepper and clove with a full body and silky smooth tannins. Perfect with lamb or steak.

Rutherford Ranch Cabernet,
Napa, California \$68

The blend of Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, and bits of other varietals showcases aromas of black cherry, black current, and plum with notes of toasty caramel. On the palate, this full-bodied silky wine has flavors of blackberries, Mission figs, clove, and well-integrated tannins.

Moss Roxx Ancient Vine Zinfandel,
Lodi, California \$60

From 100-year-old vines, this full bodied but soft and mouth-filling wine is brimming with ripe fruit flavors accompanied by hints of vanilla and milk chocolate.

Lava Cap Reserve Zinfandel,
Sierra Foothills, California \$60

Bold and firmly structured with vivid raspberry and black-cherry aromas followed by a moderately tannic palate of cranberry and raspberry flavors. 92pt Wine Enthusiast

Castle Rock Petite Sirah,

Paso Robles, California \$10/\$28

Jammy and full-bodied, with notes of blueberry, cocoa and nicely balanced oak. Delicious "California style" richness.

Klinker Brick Farrah Syrah, Lodi,
California \$13/\$36

Black fruits with hints of smoke, spice, pepper & chocolate. Lush and silky texture.

Castle Rock Merlot,
Columbia Valley \$10/\$28

Washington makes some of the best Merlot, and this is a perfect example: ripe berry and spice elements with luscious, elegant structure.

Tilia Malbec, Mendoza,
Argentina \$9/\$28

Red fruits, cherries and a soft note of plum. The palate is supple and juicy with an earthy complexity.

Catena Malbec, Mendoza,
Argentina \$44

The most famous Malbec, and for good reason: perfectly balanced with dark fruits, delicate floral notes, and traces of vanilla and mocha. Intense and concentrated

High Valley Cabernet Sauvignon,
Lake County California \$11/\$36

This bold and complex wine has subtle floral aromas with notes of cherry and leather. The finish is bright and peppery and give way to lingering fruit. 90 WE

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
