# Studio Cantares

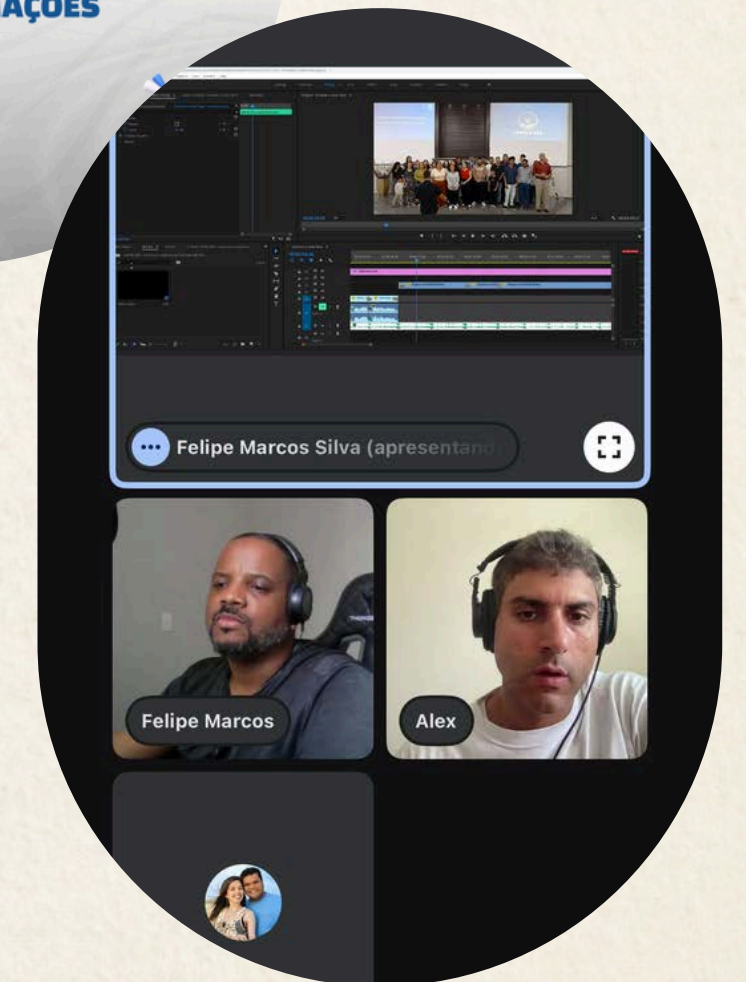
