ARCA CLASSES

We're wrapping up the very first 9-month stage of our Academy for song leaders. Earlier this month, we had the privilege of welcoming one of ARCA's directors, Alexandre Girodo, from Belo Horizonte. He taught classes on using music notation software. And on September 29th, we kicked off the last intensive week of the year with Professor Marcos Menaldo from São Paulo, focusing on vocal techniques and free singing.









INTERNSHIP ASSIGNMENTS

While Professor Alexandre was here, we announced to our students the congregations where they'll be serving for the next three months. After reviewing each request, looking at the students' profiles, the working conditions, and spending time in prayer, we made the following decisions: Juan Nogueira will serve in Campo Grande (Mato Grosso do Sul – Central Brazil), Cauê Dias will serve in Guarapuava (Paraná – Southern Brazil), and Bruno Godoy will serve in the congregation in Prazeres, right here in the Recife metro area.

Please keep these brothers in your prayers as they begin their work. Their internships will run from October 15, 2025, through January 20, 2026.

















CONFERENCE IN CURITIBA

Just like last year, I had the privilege of taking part in the "3 in 1" Conference in Curitiba, in Southern Brazil, with about 300 brothers and sisters from across the country. I always use these opportunities to share about our ministry and to build connections with potential students and church leaders. In fact, it was at last year's conference that we first connected with Bruno Godoy's family, as well as the congregations in Campo Grande and Guarapuava—both of which will receive interns this year.

WORKSHOP IN NATAL - RN

Our visit really encouraged and uplifted this hurting but welcoming congregation.







CAMPAIGN IN ARAPIRAGA - AL

For the very first time, we partnered with ARCA students, EBENSR (the School of Preaching), and members of the Cantares Ministry for a special campaign in Arapiraca, the second-largest city in Alagoas.







It was a five-hour trip that gave us many chances to serve and evangelize. We handed out flyers downtown, sang in the main square, and later visited the public hospital, singing in the entrance hall. We saw patients and families listening from the windows and thanking us for the comfort they felt. It was a powerful and moving experience that even opened doors for Bible studies and follow-up visits. The next day, we organized a day of fellowship, fun, and learning for the local youth, and on Sunday we joined all the congregations from the state—along with two others from Pernambuco and Bahia—for one big worship service. It truly was a joyful celebration to the Lord!


























NEW ARCA STUDENTS
