SOS SERTÃO OUTREACH

On October 12th, Brazil celebrates Children's Day—a day when kids usually receive gifts and enjoy games and special activities. But this year, our family chose to do something different. Instead of giving presents to our children, we joined a humanitarian outreach in one of the areas with the lowest HDI in Brazil. The Catumbaú Valley is a region marked by hardship in every way —severe drought, lack of food, limited access to education and healthcare, and above all, a people deeply in need of God.

For months, many of us collected food, water, hygiene products, Bibles, bicycles, and toys. It was a tiring weekend because of the long trip, but we drove a truck loaded with donations, and once we arrived, we offered age-based Bible classes, separate gatherings for men and women, snacks, and then distributed Bibles, toys, food baskets, bicycles, and hygiene kits.

This experience moved us deeply—especially our children, who saw firsthand the reality of missions and felt the urgency of sharing the gospel. It's an experience that will stay with them forever.
