

INTRODUCING THE FOREST KIDS RANGERS PROGRAM!

Do your kids love the outdoors, enjoy hands on learning, or have a natural curiosity about nature and traditional survival and handcraft skills? Enroll them in our **Forest Kids Rangers Program**, a unique, adventure-filled series designed to teach essential wilderness survival and wildcraft skills, alongside our regular play based curriculum that includes social studies, history and sciences.

WHY WILDCRAFT FOR KIDS?

Wildcraft is more than just survival - it's about developing confidence, responsibility, resilience and a deep respect for nature. Our program encourages kids to engage their senses, solve real-world problems, and work as a team. By learning these skills, children:

- **Build Self-Confidence** by mastering practical, age appropriate survival and craft techniques
- **Develop Resilience + Patience** through outdoor challenges that require focus and persistence
- **Connect with Nature** in a way that screens cannot replicate, sparking a lifelong appreciation for the natural world
- **Learn Teamwork + Leadership** by working together in fun, safe, and supervised scenarios

PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

Students earn unique button style badges as they learn and demonstrate proficiency in core wildcraft skills, including:

- Fire Building, Shelter Construction, Navigation + Orienteering, Knot Tying + Tool Safety, Wildlife Awareness and Identification, Foraging Basics, First Aid Basics, Teamwork, Bush Craft Candles, Constellations and Night Sky Navigation, Plant Identification, Family Adventures in Nature, Fishing and Processing, Water Purification, Hand Craft Projects, Friendship and more.



PROGRAM STRUCTURE:

Each skill completed earns the student a corresponding badge, building a visible record of their accomplishments and progress.

- Weekly lessons vary depending on the season and weather, and will include a combination of bush craft skills, handcraft projects, history or social studies unit studies or science experiments.
- To earn badges, kids will be required to demonstrate consistency in mastering each skill, which will be documented in a skill tracking report card, with a set list of requirements needing to be met.
- Students registered for all 4 sessions will receive a complimentary survival day pack, to keep all their wildcraft supplies in and display badges they have earned, as well as have the opportunity to participate in the year end field trip and end-of-program "Wildcraft Showcase."



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
