- Rain Jacket
- Quick dry clothing pants, shorts and shirts
- Team jersey, team hat
- Tackle Bag and extra line
- Water and Snacks

Weather – Be sure pack based on the weather outlook and be prepared for the worst



Daily Fishing Log

Fishing logbook or regular notebook

Items to note

- Lake and area fished
- Lures used
- Number and size of fishing caught
- Note fish caught
 - Where (shallow, docks, weed line, deep, etc)
 - Area of lake caught
 - When
 - What lure(s)
- Weather
- Barometric Pressure

- 7 7 ½' Rod Med Heavy Moderate, 17lb Florocarbon Line
- Chatterbaits, Crankbaits, Jerkbaits, Spinnerbaits

Spinning Rods

- 7 7 ½' Rod Med Fast, 10-15lb Braid Line, 8-10lb Florocarbon Leader
- Drop Shot, Ned Rig, Neko Rig, Shakey Head, Spybait, Tubes, Wacky Rigs

Accuracy, Accuracy Accuracy!

Put duct tape or electrical tape around the jig to cover the hook
