



What does **"engineered to last"** really mean? It means not just repairing your ball screw but **re-engineering** it so that it is better than it ever was before.

- Precision ground ball screws with lead errors as low as 0.0002 in/ft.
- Multiple levels of ball screw upgrades including reverse engineering, regrinding, and replacement of ball nut or screw as needed.
- Regrinding with true Gothic Arch ball form for highest stiffness and longest life.
- Standard steel through hardened internal returns, captured within the ball nut, to prevent premature failure while operating at speeds up to DN 150,000.
- Imperial sizes 0.500" to 12.000" BCD, metric sizes 12 mm to 300 mm BCD, and lengths up to 40 feet (12 meters).
