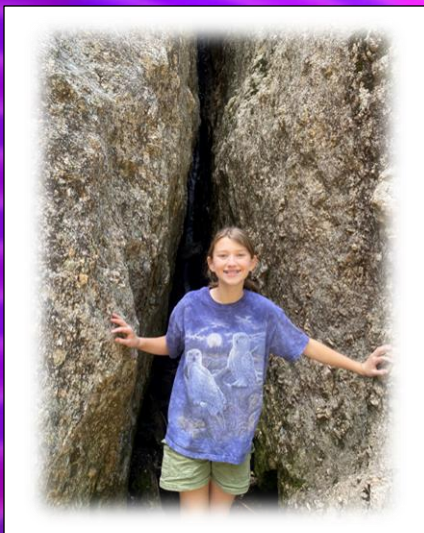

Costume Deposits/Classes

These are due NO LATER than November 14th. The costume deposit is \$55 per class for each child. These charges will be on your accounts. They DO NOT come out with autopay when your tuition does, let us know if you would like us to run your card for those charges. The remaining balance is then due in January when we get back from the break. The total of the costumes usually runs between \$75-\$95 for each class. In December I order the costumes and pay for them in full, so once you have given me a deposit, you are responsible for the remaining balance. If you have any questions about this process, please see the front desk. Again, if your child is not participating in the recital, we need to know this month. Thank you!!
