DRESS REHEARSAL IS MANDATORY!!! NO EXCEPTIONS!

If you do not attend dress rehearsal, you may not dance in the recital.

STUDENTS MUST BE AT DEER VALLEY HIGH SCHOOL ON JUNE 13TH AT 10:30 a.m. PLEASE DO NOT BE LATE!

The following dances will go first at dress rehearsal:

- ALL MINI'S CLASSES
- Ballet 5-7 A and Jazz 5-7 A
- Ballet 5-8 B and Jazz 5-8 B
- Beg H/H 6-8
- Dancers in the classes ABOVE may leave dress rehearsal when finished.
- **Important:** If your student is in *additional* classes besides those above, they will have received a second information sheet regarding Dress Rehearsal. If you have not received it, please ask for one.

Recommended/Required for Dress Rehearsal:

- 1. Make a checklist of everything that is required for dress rehearsal and recital.
- 2. Put your child's name on <u>EVERYTHING</u>. (Neither Deer Valley High School nor DMDA is responsible for lost items.)
- 3. Students must be in **full costume and make-up for dress rehearsal**.
- 4. Once rehearsal begins, we cannot go back to repeat a dance. It is imperative that you are on time.
- 5. When you arrive come into the auditorium and sit down with your child. You may stay with your child during the run through of their dances.
- 6. Rehearsal will take about an hour. When your child's dances are complete, you are welcome to stay and watch or leave for the day.

RECITAL INFORMATION

<u>Friday Evening June 14th Performance Details</u>: Please arrive by <u>5:30pm at Deer Valley High School</u>. There will be signs to direct you. Have your child dressed in his/her costume when you arrive, with hair and make-up ready.

- FRIDAY SHOW ONLY: You will be allowed to check out the little ones at intermission.
- For the Saturday show they ARE REQUIRED to stay for the entire show! We have a special finale planned for you.

CHECK IN: On arrival go to the table in the lobby where you will check in by last name.

• **NEW!** One parent will be given a sticker to wear with your dancer's name & color assignment. DO NOT LOSE THIS STICKER(S). It is required to check out your child. (If you lose your sticker, you must wait until all other children have been checked out and will be required to show ID to take your child home.)

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CHECK OUT: The **check-out** process is completed in stages by color group. Colors are assigned by age. We check out ONE color at a time from YOUNGEST to oldest. **No exceptions**. Please be patient. These procedures are for the safety of your child.

- To check your child out, go to the same place where you checked in. When your child's color is called/shown as being open to check out, show the volunteer at the door the sticker with your child's name and color assignment.
- At this point the **ONE** family member wearing the checkout sticker will be allowed to go in the dressing room to pick up your child and then exit out the **back** door.
 - Note: We ask that the family member checking out be a woman as they
 will go directly into the dressing room. If your only option for check out
 is a male family member, we will have a runner that will go in and get
 your child for you.
- Order of Colors for Check out, YOUNGEST to Oldest:

Pink
 Green
 Orange
 Blue

3. Yellow 6. Purple (Self check in/out, 13+ ONLY)

<u>Saturday Morning June 15th Performance Details:</u> Please arrive <u>by 10:30 AM.</u> Have your child dressed in his/her costume when you arrive, with hair and make-up ready.

- IMPORTANT! Your child is required to stay for the **entire Saturday show** so they may participate in the finale. **No Exceptions!**
- The students will go through the same check in/out process as Friday night.
- This show will be professionally videotaped.

Reminders for BOTH SHOWS:

- If you have any questions please ask!
- Make sure to label everything.
- Only volunteers will be allowed in the dressing room and backstage areas.
- Arrive hair and make-up ready IN costume.
- NO CAMERAS OR VIDEOTAPING IS ALLOWED DURING THE PERFORMANCES.
- NO FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY FOR THE SAFETY OF THE DANCERS.

Please be patient with each other and adhere to the rules. When we do so, the days run smoothly and are pleasant for all. Remember these shows are **all about the children** having a good time and enjoying their experience. We are very much looking forward to providing an opportunity for your dancer to shine!
