

# LITTLE ONES DRESS REHEARSAL/ RECITAL INFORMATION

## Little Ones DRESS REHEARSAL - Thursday, June 10th 10:30am Deer Valley High School

This is the best time for your little one to practice on stage, get used to the lights, spacing, entrances and exits...

PLEASE DO NOT BE LATE! Dress Rehearsal is **MANDATORY!** If you do not attend dress rehearsal, you may not dance in the recital.

### **The following dances will go first at dress rehearsal:**

- Minis: Tuesday at 9:30 and 6:15, Thursday at 6:15
- Ballet: 5-8 I and 6-9 II
- Jazz: 5-8 I and 6-9 II
- Hip Hop for Homeschoolers and Acro I

Dancers in the classes ABOVE may leave dress rehearsal when finished.

- **Important:** If your student is in *additional* classes besides those above, they will have received a second information sheet regarding Dress Rehearsal. If you have not received it, please ask for one.

### **Recommended/Required for Dress Rehearsal:**

1. Make a checklist of everything that is required for dress rehearsal and recital.
2. Put your child's name on EVERYTHING. (Neither Deer Valley High School nor DMDA is responsible for lost items.)
3. Students must be in **full costume, with hair in low bun and stage make-up for dress rehearsal**.
4. Once rehearsal begins, we cannot go back to repeat a dance. It is imperative that you are on time.
5. When you arrive, come into the auditorium and sit down with your child. You may stay with your child during the run through of their dances.
6. Rehearsal will take about an hour. When your child's dances are complete, you are welcome to stay and watch or leave once their dance practice is finished.

# LITTLE ONES DRESS REHEARSAL/ RECITAL INFORMATION

## Little Ones RECITAL - Saturday, June 12th 9:45am - 12:30pm Deer Valley High School

**9:45am CHECK IN:** Go to the table in the lobby where you will check in by last name. Reminder! *Have your child dressed in his/her 1st costume with hair in a low bun & make-up ready. Other costumes, shoes, accessories in hand.*

- **IMPORTANT!** One parent will be given a sticker to wear with your dancer's name and check out time.
- **DO NOT LOSE THIS STICKER(S).** It is required to check out your child. (If you lose your sticker, you must wait until all other children have been checked out and will be required to show ID to take your child home.)

### **10:15am and 11:30am PERFORMANCE TIME!**

- **Dancers will stay backstage the entire time from check in to check out.**
- **IMPORTANT!** Your child is required to stay for the **entire Group 1 show**. They will be in two performances. **No Exceptions!**
- The 11:30am show will be professionally videotaped.

**12:30pm CHECK OUT:** Your Check Out sticker (received at check in) is required for check out AFTER their final performance is complete.

- To check your child out the **ONE** family member wearing the checkout sticker will:
  - Go to the same place where you checked in
  - Show the volunteer at the door the sticker with your child's name on it
  - Enter the dressing room to pick up your child and then exit out the **back** door. (The rest of the family will meet their "star" outside.)
- Note: For female dancers, we ask that the family member checking out be a woman as they will go directly into the dressing room and there may be dancers changing at this time for the next Group performance. If your only option is a male family member, we will have a runner go in and get your child for you. For male performers, any parent may check out as our gentleman will not be changing at this time.
- Please be patient. These procedures are for the safety of your child.

### **Reminders:**

1. Make sure to label everything and if you have any questions please ask!
2. Only volunteers will be allowed in the dressing room and backstage areas.
3. **NO CAMERAS, FLASH PHOTOGRAPHY OR VIDEOTAPING IS ALLOWED DURING THE PERFORMANCES FOR THE SAFETY OF THE DANCERS.**

Please be patient with each other and adhere to the rules. When we do so, the day runs smoothly and is pleasant for all. Remember these shows are **about the children** having a good time and enjoying their experience. We are very much looking forward to providing an opportunity for your dancer to shine!
