

Guidelines

- To hold a date we charge a non-refundable retainer fee. We do a simple contract and can provide insurance docs for venues. We are licensed in the City of Modesto to conduct business.
- All of our packages and prices include set up and tear down. On average we arrive at the venue to set up 1-2 hours before the event begins.
- We are located in Modesto and charge a travel fee for events that exceed 20 miles from our base. It will be added to the price.
- If an event is 2 or more hours from Modesto and ends late (9PM+) we charge a lodging fee so we can get a room for the night.
- Destination weddings in places like Yosemite, Lake Tahoe and along the coast require custom pricing. Please contact us for a quote.
- Wedding venues and homes vary in size and terrain. Places with longer distances, stairs, dirt, grass and other challenges may require more time, effort and a higher price.
- The average Central Valley wedding is roughly 160 guests. Weddings that exceed this may require more gear, time for set up, and a higher price. Weddings and parties of 300+ run about 25% more.
- We are professional DJ's not a rental company. Our equipment is not suited for singers and instruments. Therefore we do not provide audio, connections or live mixing for quartets, solo artists, bands, worship leaders, mariachi and so on. If you are planning to have live music at your event, please make the appropriate arrangements with your talent. Ask them to bring their own sound system, mics, stands, cables, operators, etc.
- After years of working in the entertainment industry we have found that the engagement and energy of an event is maximized when our highly skilled DJ's choose the songs for open dancing. Because of this we will not accept full playlists. If a client wants certain songs for this moment they can list them as Must Plays and we will do our best to fit them in. We will however accept Spotify playlists for the Prelude (60 minutes), Cocktail Hour (90 minutes) and Dinner Hour (180 minutes).
- We are **CLEAN** DJ's so please be mindful of the music you choose for your event. Songs with excessive explicit content (Gangster Rap, etc.) should not be played at weddings where there tend to be small children, grandparents and a few religious folks. Plus, there are "Clean" versions of nearly every song out

there. Our mission is to cultivate a fun and memorable celebration without offending your guests.
