What is the Giving Tree?

It is a winter tree created outside the cafeteria that is filled with leaves, each with a label with a toy, item, or gift card request for a child or family in need. The primary goal of the tree this year is to serve Barnwell families in need. Any donations which exceed the needs of Barnwell families will be donated to North Fulton Community Charities (www.nfcc.org). Your donation of a NEW, UNWRAPPED item or gift card will first serve the needs of any Barnwell family in need. Once the needs of Barnwell families are met, remaining items will stock the ‘Santa Shop’ at NFCC so *families in need in our community* can go and ‘shop’ for their children, free of charge. NFCC anticipates serving over 2,000 children in need this holiday season.

When is the Giving Tree?

Your child’s class will go and collect leaves off the tree between Dec. 2 and Dec. 11, and then gift drop off is Dec. 10th and 12^h.
