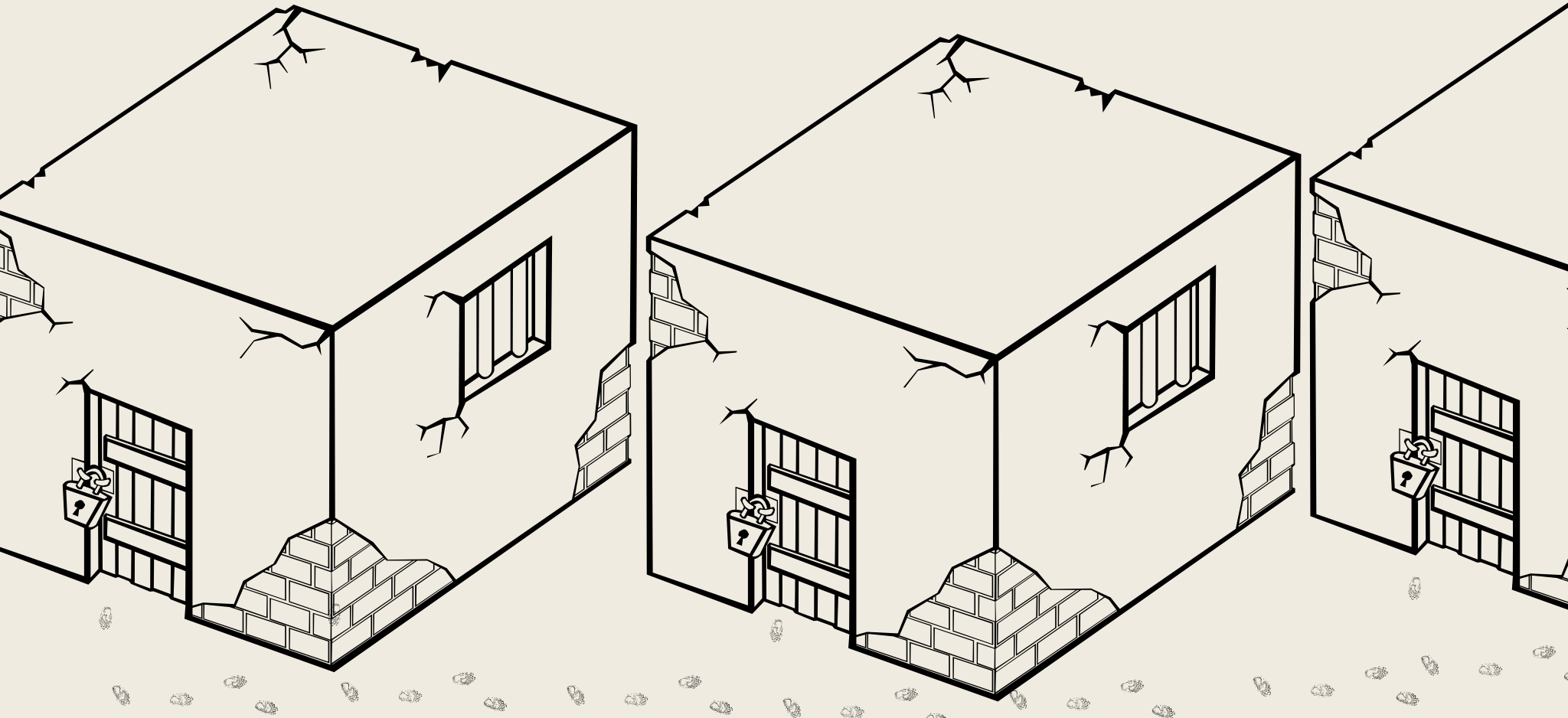




Prayers from Prison

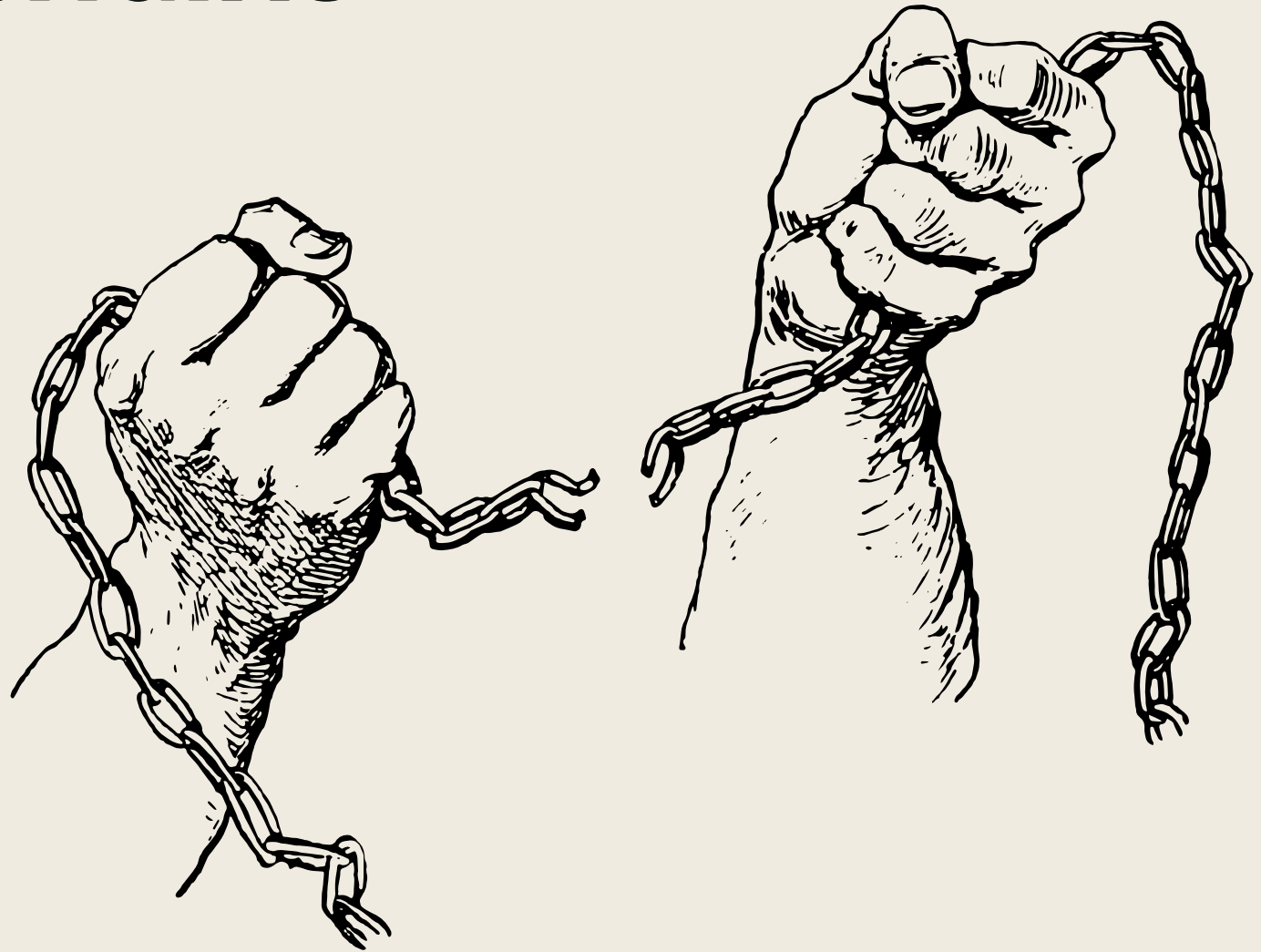


The prayer of a

effective.

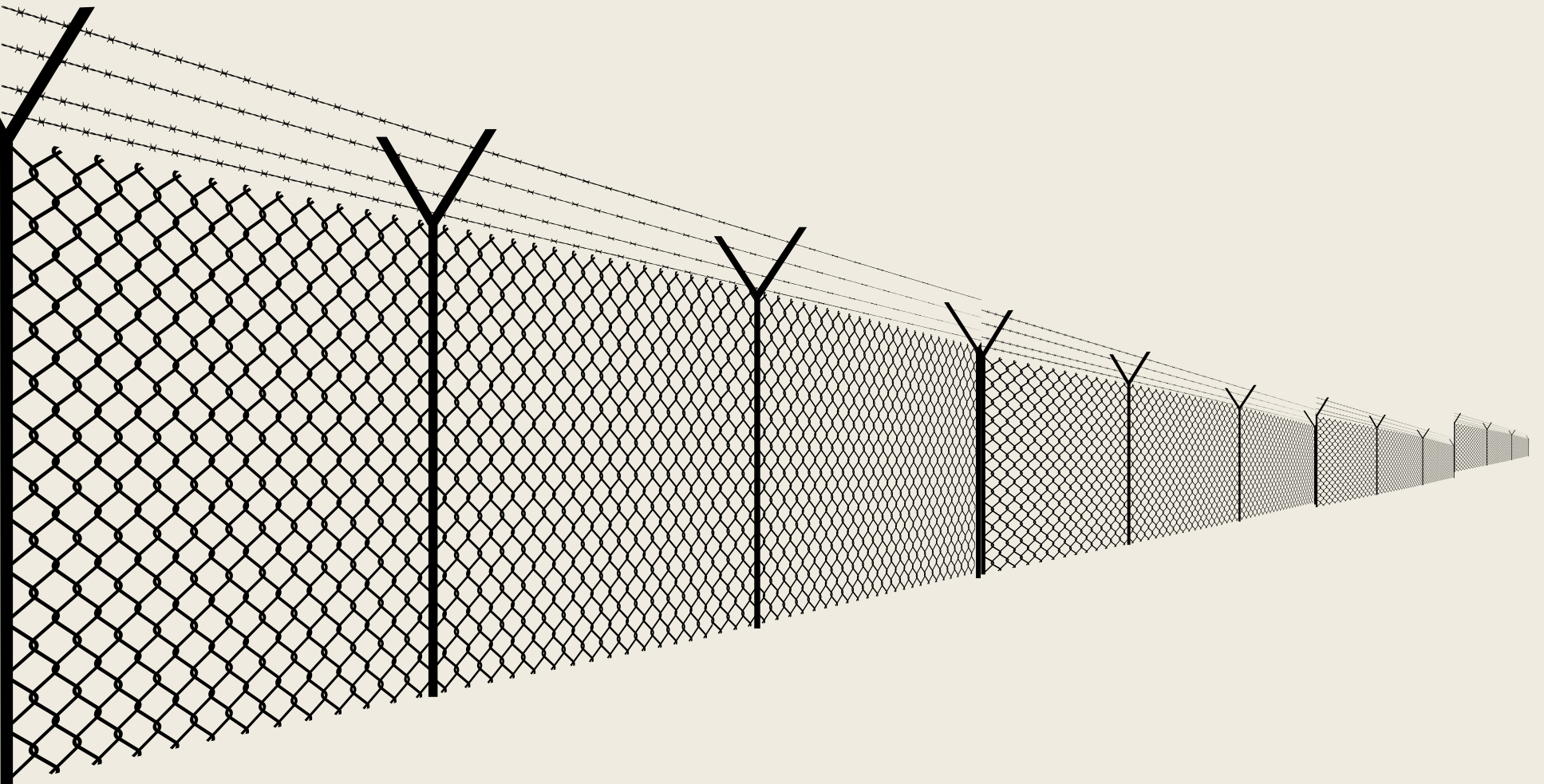

and suddenly there was a great **earthquake**, so that the foundations of the prison were shaken. And immediately all the doors were opened, and everyone's bonds were unfastened.

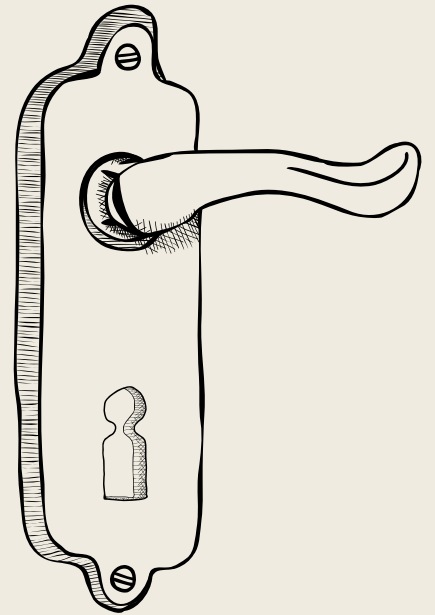

are opened

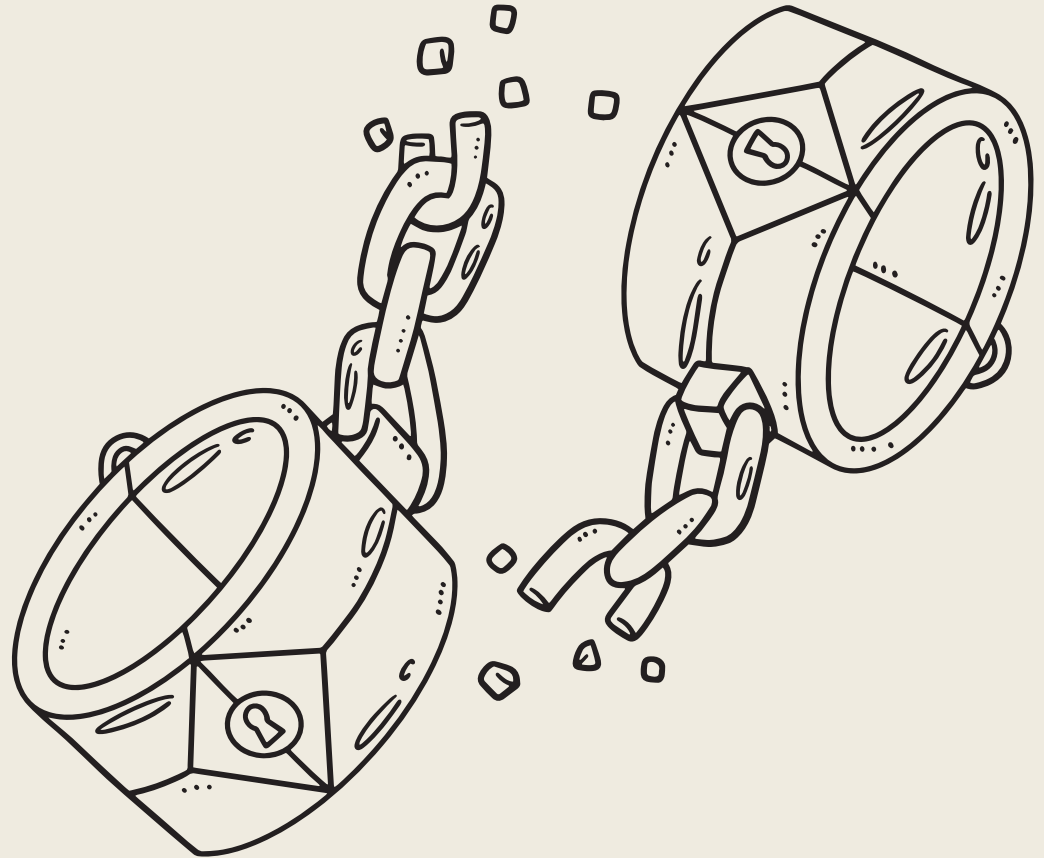


Behold, I have set

and your household.**”

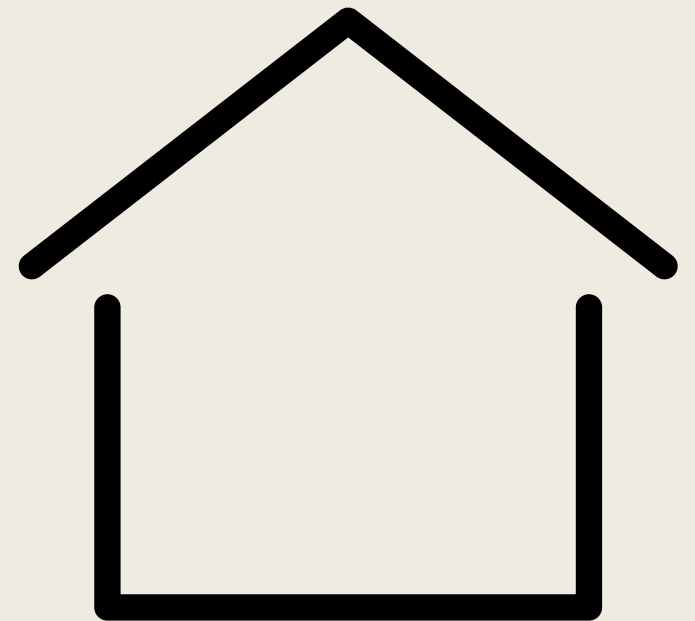

done previously.

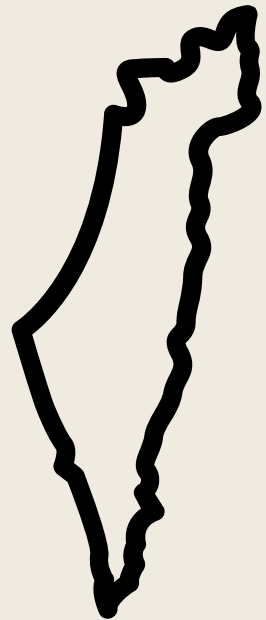
Daniel 6:10 | ESV
